**Student Council Report**

**Voted:** To accept the second reading and adopt of JJIC.

Chairwoman Aubrey opened the floor to discussion. Board members suggested changes and clarification to the High School Athletic Eligibility section relative to failing grades and the number of credits a student must have to participate. It was also noted that poor attendance should affect a student's eligibility and clarification of that provision in the policy was suggested. Numerous motions to amend the policy were made resulting in following standing motions:

**Voted:** To amend policy JJIC, number 7 to read "...for unacceptable behavior, poor performance or poor attendance. **Having no further discussion Chairwoman Aubrey called the vote; the motion carried 8-0-0.**

**Committee Assignments**

Chairwoman Aubrey presented a list of school board committees and their functions. She noted that members who are not on a specific committee, but wish to be, are more than welcome to attend those meetings; however board members must be careful not to create a board quorum.

**Goals**

Chairwoman Aubrey presented the 2010-2011 goals and asked each board member to review and be ready to discuss them at the next meeting scheduled for April 21, 2011. She asked that any ideas or thoughts be emailed to her prior to the meeting.

**Legislative Update**

Mr. La Salle presented a PowerPoint presentation on the current legislative activity at the state level and how this activity proposes to affect the school district's budget relative to adequacy, funding, retirement system reform, tenure, and tax caps. He provided a table reflecting worst case and best case scenarios relative to district revenues for adequacy grants, building aid, catastrophic aid, vocational education transportation and driver education aid. He reviewed House Bill 337 and Senate Bill 183 which changes the definition of adequacy as well as House Bills 1 and 2 regarding funding and House Bill 580 regarding retirement system reform and Senate Bill 2 regarding the adoption of spending caps by municipalities. He rounded out his presentation by proposing the district's response in being prepared for the worst and hoping for the best. This will play out in a close monitoring of the state budget process, developing a plan for retirement cost "down shift, and continuing to follow related bills and legislation.

**Administrators Report**

Mr. La Salle recognized the Young Inventor's Program noting numerous district students winning awards and recognition. He also congratulated the High School and the Evening Division program on their invitation to present at a consortium held in Nashua. Their presentation is on rubrics and assessment.

He then brought up a vocational funding matter that was first raised by students attending the vocational program at Pinkerton. There are not enough students attending the vocational program to warrant a school bus to transport the students back and forth to Pinkerton; however, the district has been subsidizing the cost of transportation with the students using grant monies. He went on to say he spoke with Mr. Stokinger and they calculated that at 20 mpg it takes approximately 1.3 gallons of gas per day to travel to and from Pinkerton Academy. After calculating travel for 180 days per year it costs students each approximately \$820 per year. The students are currently being reimbursed around \$500 per year. Discussion on increasing the subsidy transpired noting funding for this would come from administrative travel reimbursement accounts. Also noted was the uniqueness of the program at Pinkerton, attendance factors, length of consideration – cover through next year, and the policies of other schools.

**On a motion by Mr. Collins, seconded by Mrs. Withee**

**Voted:** To reimburse the students \$3.50 per day as proposed by Mr. La Salle.

**Having no further discussion Chairwoman Aubrey called the vote; the motion carried 8-0-0.**

**Committee and Reports of the School Board**

Mrs. Withee reported on band activities for the middle and high schools as well as announced that the next Facilities Committee meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, April 12<sup>th</sup> at the SAU.

Mr. Collins reported on the organizational meeting of the Budget Committee; all seats filled and Mrs. O'Neil was re-elected to chair position. The Community Relations meeting is scheduled before the next school board meeting at 6:30 pm.

Chairwoman Aubrey extended best wishes to students going All State Finals; she noted the upcoming Safety Committee meeting and a pancake breakfast at Applebees to sponsor the post prom party.

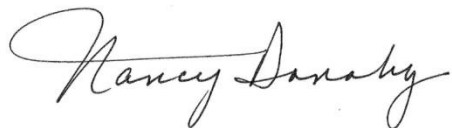
**Correspondence**
