Call to Order

Madam Chair Kosta called this April 1, 2010 meeting of the Timberlane Regional School Board to order at 7:30 pm. Roll call was taken.

Pledge

Madam Chair Kosta led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Minutes

The board reviewed the non-public meeting minutes of March 4, 2010 meeting and the March 18, 2010 minutes of the organizational, regular and non-public sessions.

Motion: Mrs. Withee motioned to approve the minutes of the March 4, 2010 non-public meeting, and the March 18, 2010 organizational, regular and non-public meeting minutes with corrections. Mr. Mascola seconded. With the noted corrections and no further discussion, the motion carried 6-0.

Delegations and Individuals

Ms. Jackie Efraimson, Community Agent, informed the board of the Student Council's busy winter activities. She reported on the first March Sprit Week as well as the first annual Fun Festival, noting the success of both events. Currently the Student Council is ending their 2009-2010 school year with a banquet scheduled for April 13, 2010. The Big Buddy Little Buddy event is scheduled at the Pollard School for May 7, 2010.

Ms. Holly Ange, Student Representative to the School Board, reported on the happenings at the high school. She noted the success of the Language Night and thanked all who participated. She congratulated the Wind Ensemble for their performance at the Large Group event and the many instrumentalist and singers who will be attending Allstate scheduled for April 10th and 11th, 2010. She reported that a fund raiser for the Leigh Buckley Scholarship was a success.

Carol Grant, resident of Atkinson, presented information regarding an organized sports team for handicapped students. The organization is called Challenger Little League. She was concerned that parents of handicapped individuals were not aware of this league. She asked the school board to consider communicating this information regarding the program to families in the district. Madam Chair Kosta informed Mrs. Grant that the board will take the matter under advisement. Mr. La Salle asked Mrs. Grant to contact his administrative assistant, Mrs. Belcher, to provide contact information regarding this league.

Current Business

Madam Chair Kosta asked the board to consider changing the agenda order for Current Business. She asked that the scoreboard purchase be heard first with Language Arts second and then the report from Pollard Elementary, re-nominations, summer hours, committee assignments and then finish with school board goals.

Motion: Mrs. Aubrey motioned to approve the changes to the April 1, 2010 agenda as stated. Mrs. Withee

seconded. With no further discussion, the motion carried 6-0.

Scoreboard purchase

Mr. Fantasia asked for the board's consideration in the purchase of a scoreboard for the recently renovated soccer field. Mr. Fantasia provided documentation of the estimated cost for the scoreboard (\$7,500.00). This estimate included a scoreboard with two panels for the school district's logo with two additional 18" X 8" ad/logo signs. He noted that ad/logo space can be sold to sponsors to pay for the cost of the sign, the added logo boards, installation and power to the sign.

Mr. Fantasia expressed his concern that business sponsorship/logos may be considered a violation of *School Board Policy KH, Public Solicitation in the Schools*. He noted that other scoreboards around the fields have some recognition of the contributors; however, he feels the scoreboards are not commercial advertisement.

Mrs. Withee asked if Mr. Fantasia discussed this project with Mr. Hughes, Director of Facilities. Mr. Fantasia confirmed that he and Mr. Hughes will work together if this project moves forward.

Mr. Fantasia suggested that additional information be provided before the board is asked for final approval. This information should include estimates for maintenance, location of the scoreboard and sponsor recognition.

Language Arts

Mrs. Killen presented an overview of the essential components of reading instruction. She noted that the Reading Street tool provides phonics and comprehensive skills. She highlighted the 5th grade work structure and the goal for readers to become skilled learners.

Each day the class works together as a whole, in smaller groups and one on one. The books used are *Just Right Books* and are matched to the student which provides access to interesting reading material. She noted it is a proven instructional strategy of the gradual release model of instruction.

One of the many aspects of this teaching tool (Reading Street) is the task for 5th graders to prepare lessons for 1st grade students. Mrs. Killen reiterated that she is always open to suggestions. Madam Chair Kosta and Mr. Paone attended the social studies workshops and witnessed the versatile aspects of Reading Street.

Department Report - Pollard School

Ms. Auger and Mrs. Joyce were excited to be given the opportunity to boast about Pollard School. They took a snap shot in time on Monday by visiting class rooms and taking pictures of students as they learn and then incorporated them into this evening's presentation.

Ms. Auger reported that this year the theme is racing which highlights the *I do, We do and You do* message. She stated her excitement in showing grades 1 through 5 in whole and small groups as well as at one to one reading times.

In her picture presentation she showed independent reading times with students using *Just Right Books* and she expressed her excitement about the curriculum. The pictures show many students enjoying reading alone, in small groups and whole classrooms with their teacher's support. She talked about the progression of students as they incorporate the theme *I do, We do and You do* in Everyday Math and other curriculum.

Ms. Auger reported that Reading Street is intergrading reading with science, social studies, music, arts and technology which is helping students learn. She informed the board the TLC program has embraced the Reading Street philosophy by having three and four year olds spend 15 minutes per day on reading skills, stating again how Reading Street helps students of all ages learn.

Ms. Auger and Mrs. Joyce reported that staff chooses charities each year and students can pledge to the teacher's charity choice instead of gift giving. It has been very successful over the years. They also have family swaps and are proud to receive one of the Energy Star awards. She spoke of her Professional Learning Community and thanked the board for the opportunity to show off the students from the Pollard School.

Re-nominations

Mr. La Salle informed the board that teachers who have completed three years of teaching are moved to the *Continuing Contract* status from a *Non-continuing Contract* which is an annual contract. He then recommended nominating the Pupil Personnel Services professional staff that are currently on continuing contract.

Summer Hours


Other

Mr. La Salle noted that two building projects will be scheduled this summer. First, the Atkinson Academy kitchen with an estimated cost of \$225,000.
