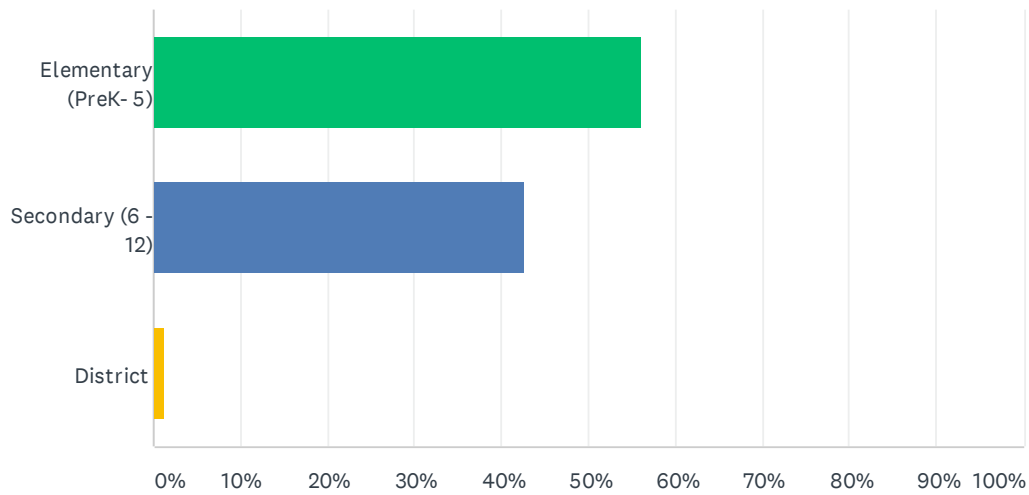


## Q1 Your District Level

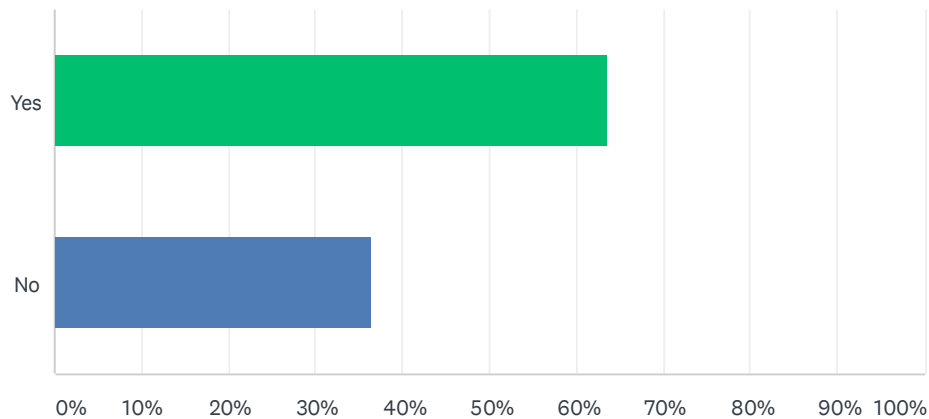

## Q2 Have you had any Video Conference sessions with students to date?

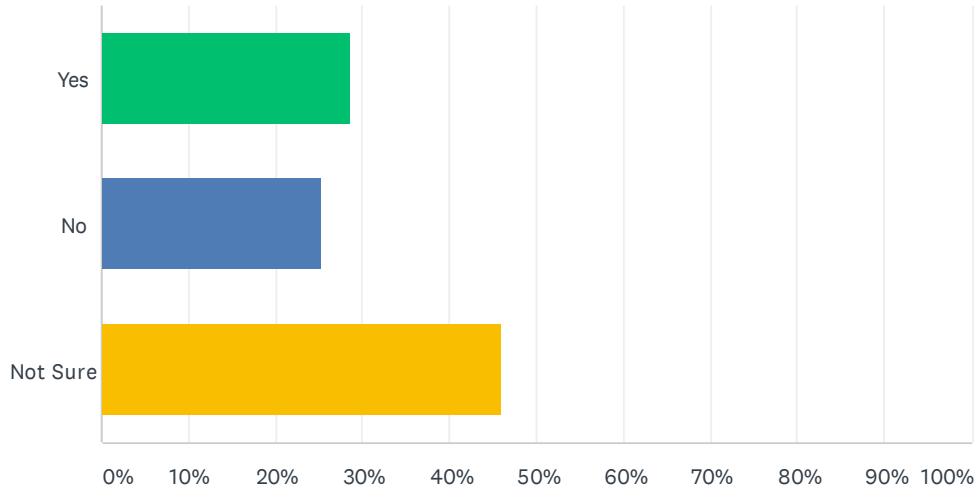

### Q3 If you answered No above do you plan to offer Video Conferencing with students?

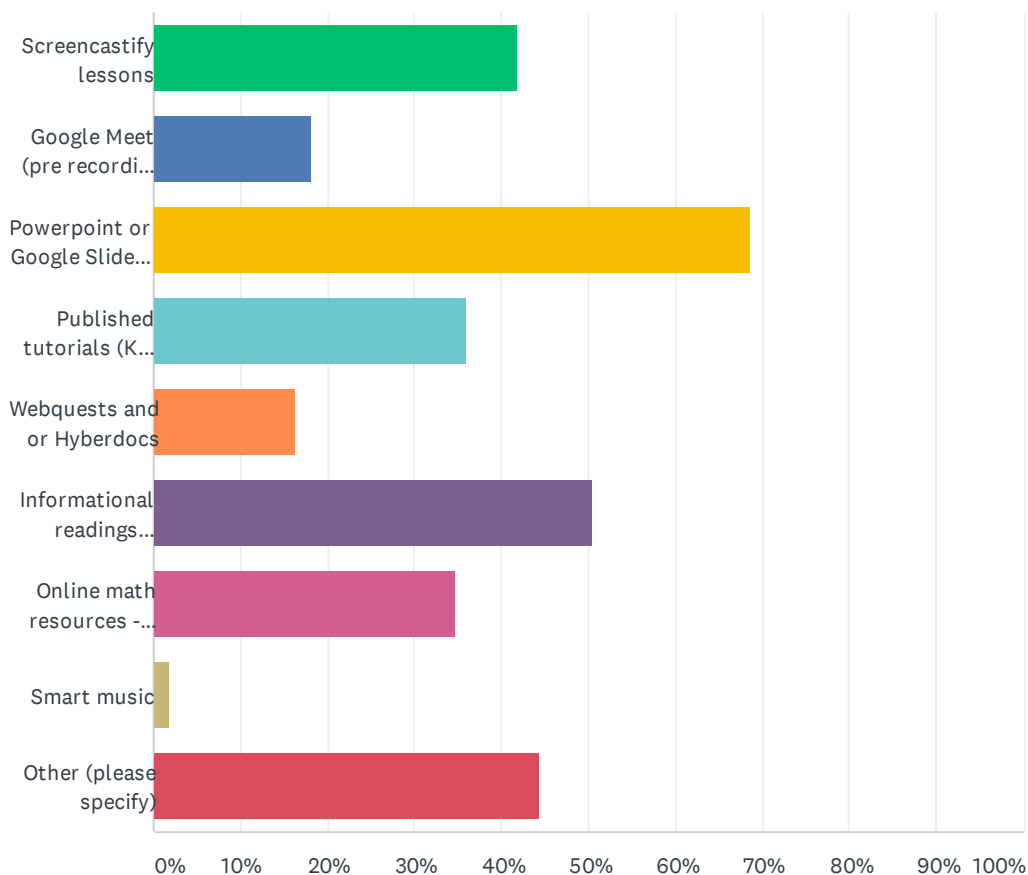

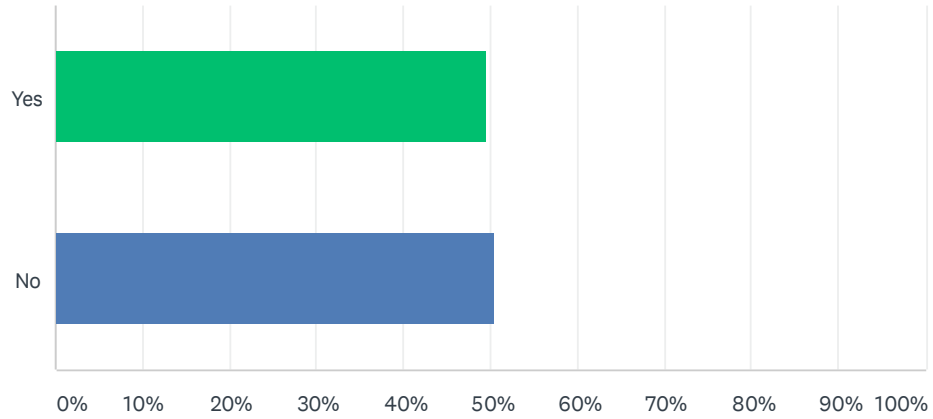
