## **PUBLIC GIFTS AND DONATIONS**

Gifts from organizations, community groups and/or individuals, which will benefit the District, shall be encouraged. A gift shall be defined as money, real or personal property and personal services provided without consideration.

Individuals or groups contemplating presenting a gift to a school or the district shall be encouraged to discuss in advance with the Building Principal or the Superintendent what gifts are appropriate and needed.

The Board reserves the right to refuse any gift that does not contribute to the achievement of the district's goals, or in which the ownership of the gift would tend to deplete the resources of the district. In determining whether a gift will be accepted, consideration shall be given to district policies, school district goals and objectives (with particular emphasis on the goal of providing equal educational opportunities to all students) and adherence to basic principles outlined in the regulation that accompanies this policy.

The Superintendent may accept gifts in the amount of \$500 or less. Gifts in excess of \$500 may only be accepted by the Board. Additionally, pursuant to RSA 198:20-b, gifts in the amount of \$5000 or more shall require the Board to hold a public hearing regarding any action to be taken with the gift. For gifts of less than \$5000, the Board will post notice of the gift in the agenda of the next regularly scheduled Board meeting and will include notice in the minutes of the meeting in which the gift is discussed. The acceptance of all gifts will be made in public session.

Any gift accepted shall become the property of the district, may not be returned without the approval of the Board, and is subject to the same controls and regulations as are other properties of the district. The Board shall be responsible for the maintenance of any gift it accepts.

At the time of acceptance of the gift, there will be a definite understanding with regard to the use of the gift, including whether it is intended for the use of one particular school or all schools in the district. The Board will make every effort to honor the intent of the donor in its use of the gift, but reserves the right to utilize any gift it accepts in the best interest of the educational program of the district. In no case shall acceptance of a gift be considered to be an endorsement by the Board of a commercial product or business enterprise or institution of learning.

It is the responsibility of the Superintendent or designee to process the appropriate forms to update inventory and to notify the donor of acceptance or rejection of a gift.

# MISSION STATEMENT

- The common end goal is to provide District transportation at its lowest cost while maintaining safe and efficient transportation to the four towns.



# NH RSA 189:6

- **189:6 Transportation of Pupils.** – The local school district shall furnish transportation to all pupils in grade 1 through grade 8 who live more than 2 miles from the school to which they are assigned. The local school board **may** furnish transportation to kindergarten pupils, pupils in grades above the eighth or to any pupils residing less than 2 miles from the school to which they are assigned, when it finds that this is appropriate, and shall furnish it when so directed by the commissioner of education.



# NH RSA 189:8

- **189:8 Limitations and Additions.** – Pupils entitled to transportation in accordance with RSA 189:6 **may** be required to walk a distance not to exceed one mile to a school bus stop established by the local school board. Pupils residing in areas which are **inaccessible** by a local school district's established mode of transportation may be required to walk a distance not to exceed 1- 1/2 miles to a school bus stop, provided that the vehicle, route and schedule have been approved by the commissioner of education. School districts shall assure that pupils shall not be subject to unsafe conditions while walking the required distance to a school bus stop and that the school bus stop is established in a safe location.



# ARTICLES OF AGREEMENT

- “The Timberlane Regional School District *shall* provide transportation for all pupils **grades 1 through 12**, to the schools within the District, consistent with RSA 189:8.....”



# DISTRICT POLICY

## STUDENT TRANSPORTATION SERVICES – EEA

### General Operating Policy

- The Superintendent shall establish bus routes and bus stops and shall comply with RSA 189 and the procedural provisions set forth in District procedure EEA-R. Routes will be developed annually and posted.



# HISTORY OF TRSD BUSING

## Feb 2002

- High School and Middle School students rode the same buses
- Sandown North and Sandown Central rode on the same buses
- At dismissal: half of buses were parked in front of TRHS; half of buses were parked in front of TRMS. When loaded they would continue to the alternate school to load rest of students before starting the route.
- Many bus misconduct issues due to mostly 8<sup>th</sup> graders and freshman or other upperclassman not getting along.
- **29 buses**

## September 2003

- TRHS and TRMS students were separated on buses. Sandown North and Sandown Central were separated on buses to shorten travel time and address conduct issues.
- No change in # of buses (**29 buses**)



# HISTORY OF TRSD BUSING

## September 2005

- TRHS and TRMS students rode separate buses. Sandown North and Sandown Central rode separate buses.
- One (1) bus was added for Danville/Sandown Middle School and SN Elementary due to increase in student counts on middle school buses and allow for shorter rides for Sandown North students.
- **30 buses**

## September 2008

- Contract renewed with Laidlaw (2008 – 2013)
- TRHS and TRMS students rode separate buses. Sandown North and Sandown Central rode separate buses.
- **30 buses**



# HISTORY OF TRSD BUSING

## September 2009

- Edulog Transportation software implemented. Web Query available to parents to find bus stops (newspapers no longer printing routes).
- Dismissal buses are moved from front of TRMS and TRHS to back of schools. School times adjusted to meet student needs and accommodate bus arrival and dismissal times to help with flow of traffic and buses not late to elementary schools. (TRHS 5 minutes earlier, TRMS 15 minutes later, Elementary Schools 10 minutes later.)

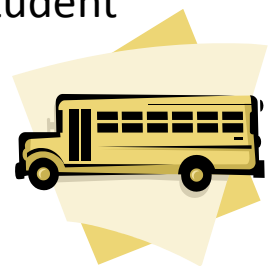
## September 2012

- Reduce one (1) bus for budget reasons
- Eliminated a Plaistow middle school route and Atkinson elementary route
- **29 buses**

## September 2013

Contract renewed with Laidlaw (2013 – 2018); company merged with First Student  
No change in management personnel made for smooth transition
