- Collaborate with teachers, parents, and administrators to support students' academic success and overall well-being.
- Collaborate with the Work-Based Learning Specialist to support internships, career exploration, and pathway opportunities for students.
- Assist with administering and interpreting assessments that help students understand their strengths, interests, and future opportunities.
- Attend annual case conferences (ACC) and collaborate in supporting students with identified learning needs.
- Maintain accurate and confidential records of student interactions, academic progress, and counseling services.
- Coordinate EVSC Innovative Program opportunities by planning the annual SICTC visit, arranging student school-day visits, managing acceptances, updating schedules, and communicating with families.
- Work closely with the counseling team to coordinate counseling programs, student orientation, testing, curriculum support, record keeping, and other student services.
