- **Summer School Report**

Summer School used a new credit recovery program called Edgenuity. Thank you to the Summer School Staff who worked hard from January to May on the transition from NovaNet to Edgenuity so we were ready to go in June. 36 students took part in the credit recovery portion of the summer school program.

- **Credit recovery** we had a 78% success rate with 28 of 36 students passing their credit recovery assignments.

Both staff and students alike were happy with the first meetings and look forward to what this year in advisory will bring.
- **September 8** – Evening adult classes are also starting and registration is open for all adult classes.

- **September 12** – Student Council Color Run, 9:00 AM -1:00 PM at THRS
- **September 14** - Evening Division for students starts this week with a full slate of classes.
