### **SUMMER ACTIVITIES LEARNING**

The Board recognizes that student learning is an ongoing process and that it is important for students to engage in learning activities even when not attending school. ~~Therefore, the Board encourages s~~Students *will be expected to have a plan complete for* summer activities that support student learning. *For students who have completed 8<sup>th</sup> grade and beyond there will be required summer work.*

~~Such activities may include a summer book reading list, attending an education-themed summer camp, engaging in extended learning opportunities, or other activities that support student learning. After successful completion of 8<sup>th</sup> grade, students may take credit bearing courses, either at the high school or in an alternative setting, as defined by Policy IMBC – Alternative Credit Options for High School Graduation, after July 1<sup>st</sup>. The Board also encourages all levels of schools within the district to offer enrichment type classes and for-credit classes, both for credit recovery and other reasons, at the high school as well.~~

~~Credit can be given earned upon the successful completion of an approved summer school program. These credits will carry the same value as those earned during the school year. If a student in grade 9-12 wishes to take a summer course for credit that is an addition to the student's program rather than for a course that is being repeated the course shall be taken at an approved summer school, and the course must have the prior approval of his/her guidance counselor if inside the school district or by the principal or his/her designee if outside the school district. Students who intend to complete course work for credit outside of the Timberlane Regional School District, must seek prior approval from building principal or designee.~~
