Dear KPA Families,

We are pleased to announce that KPA will be continuing Financial Aid in the upcoming school year. As a result of generous donors to the [Chuck Walker Memorial Scholarship Fund](#), KPA will be offering financial aid to families who qualify. Please keep in mind that in order to be eligible for financial aid, families must also apply for a [TEFA](#) (Texas Education Freedom Account) first.

KPA utilizes the online service of ISM's Financial Aid for School Tuition (FAST) to process applications. FAST will be the standard submission format for all applications. FAST provides an independent and objective assessment of the circumstances to make recommendations for financial aid. All information from FAST is kept confidential. Making use of a third party provides a fair and equitable process to determine financial aid. Taking into account the recommendation from FAST, the administration at KPA will issue financial aid up to 50% of a family's tuition needs (or as long as funds for financial aid are available). To be considered for financial aid in the upcoming school year, returning families please submit your application to FAST by May 1 and new families need to submit their applications to FAST by July 1.

Click "Start Application" to begin.

The application process is self-guided. You may navigate in and out of the program allowing you to partially complete an application and go back to it at another time. FAST has a helpline available to you should you have any questions, which can be reached by calling 1-877-326-FAST (3278), and families can reach out to customer service via email at familysupport@ismfast.com.

The non-refundable charge for the application is \$53.00 and to be paid by credit card (Visa, MasterCard, Discover or American Express) after all sections have been completed.

After completing the online application, you will be required to upload your most recent tax documents (federal taxes including all schedules, state taxes and W-2s) to FAST for verification purposes. The application is not complete and cannot be reviewed until all the required information and documentation has been submitted.

While no financial aid procedure can be entirely equitable – there are simply too many individual factors and extenuating circumstances – this process that has been selected serves our school community very well. Among its many features are the ability to further secure your financial data and maintain a high degree of confidentiality.
