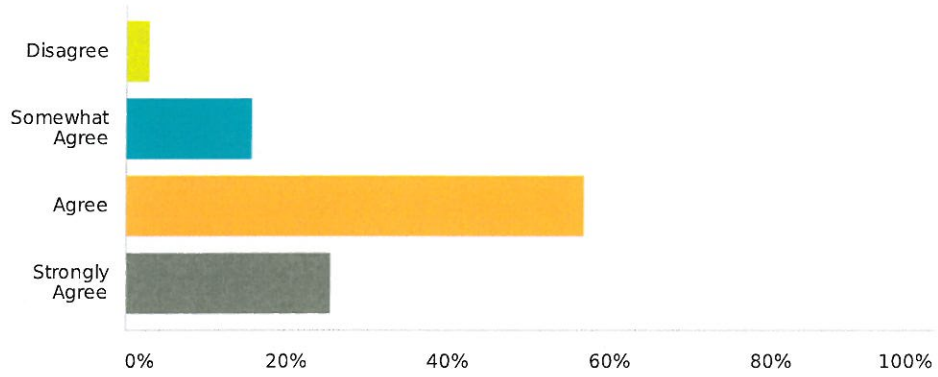


Q2 I understand the Standards-Based Grading System.

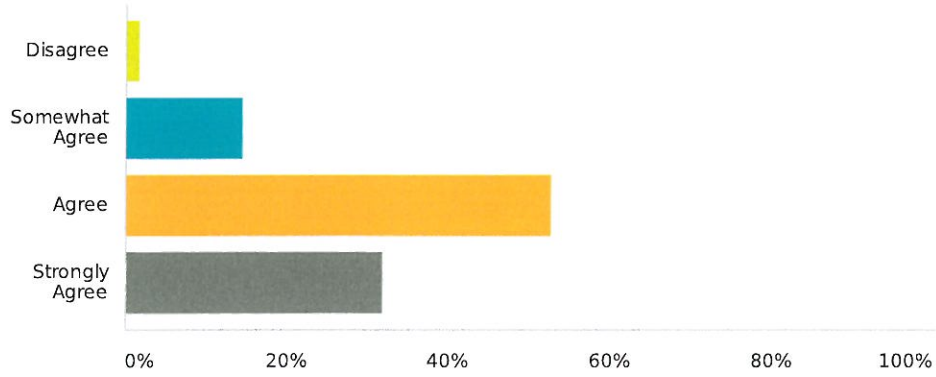

Q3 My teachers have clearly explained the way they grade (assess) my learning of the standards.

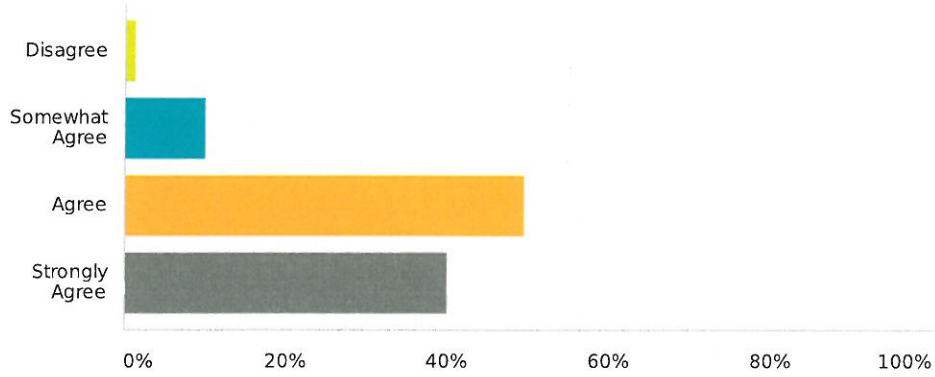

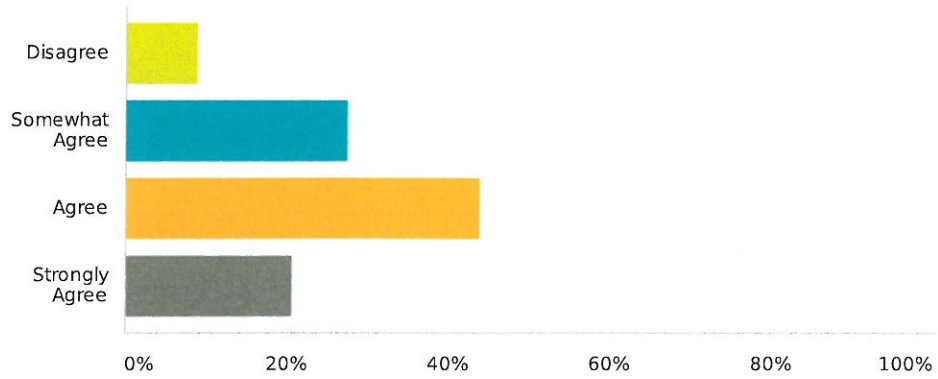

Q5 Four-point rubrics help me understand how well I am doing on a standard.

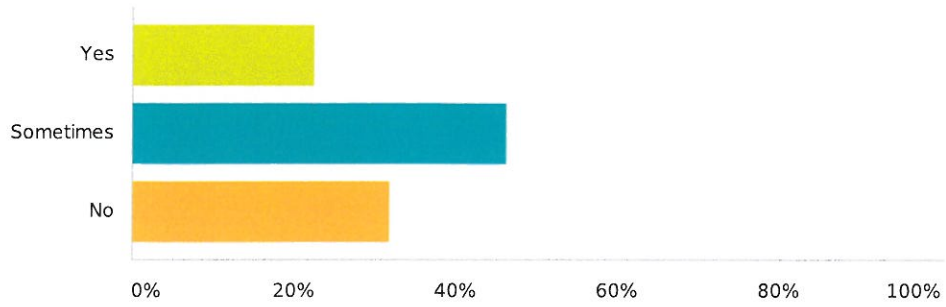

Q6 I have had an opportunity to give feedback on the rubrics being used.

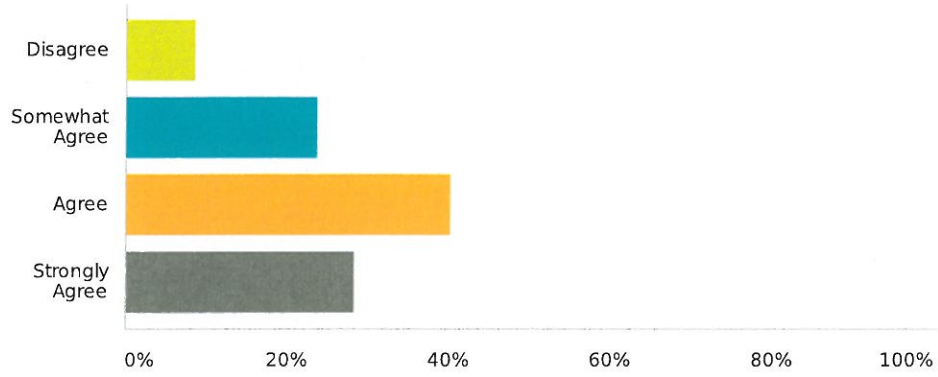

Q7 When a summative is returned to me, the rubric helps me to clearly see what I did well and what I can improve upon.

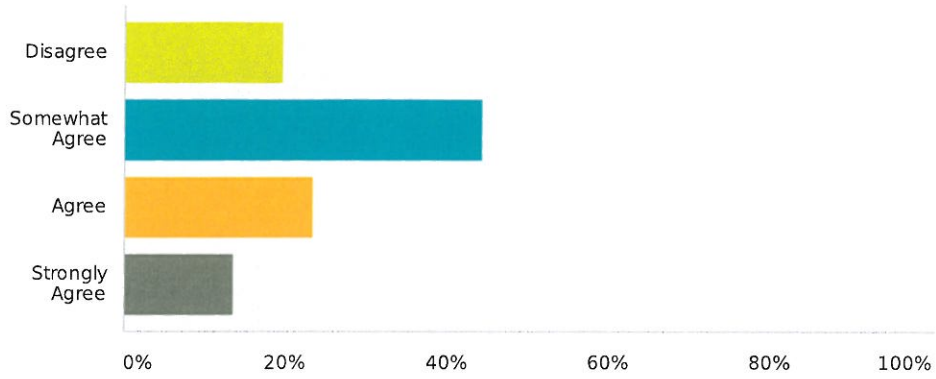

Q8 I find it difficult to reach the Exemplary level on the standards.

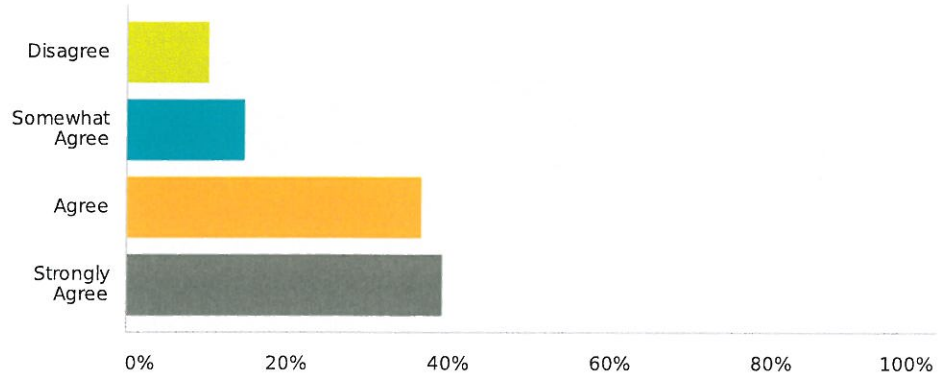
