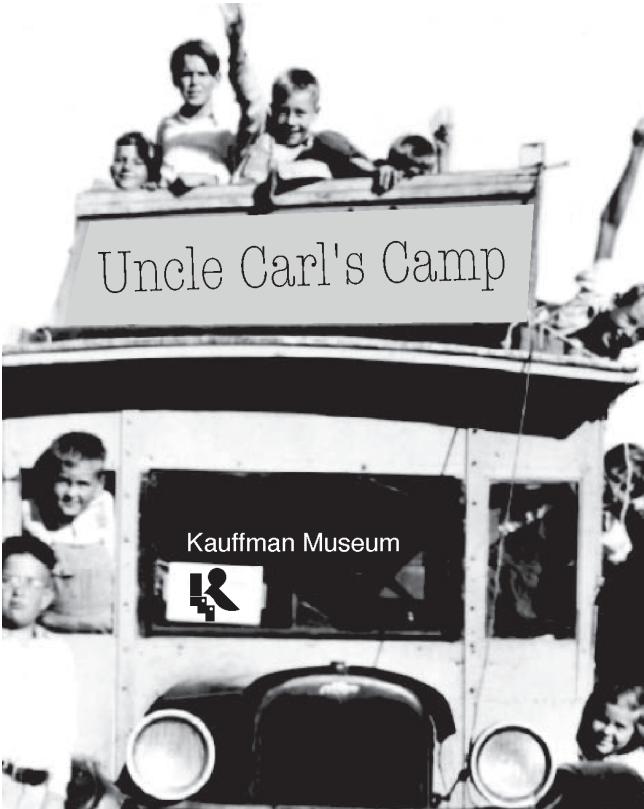




Charles Kauffman,

Age: 11-14 (Completed Grade 5-8 or above)

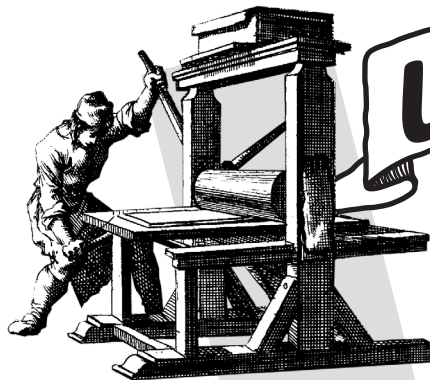
