NWCA Scholarships are awarded to children/grandchildren of an Enlisted member of the Navy, Marine Corps or Coast Guard on active duty, or retired with pay or the child/grandchild of a deceased member of these categories. Applicants must have a valid dependent's ID card (United States Uniformed Services Identification and Privileges Card). Applicants must show basis of need for financial assistance, have a scholastic standing of at least a 2.5 grade point average (GPA), and be a graduate of an accredited high school or its equivalent or will qualify for graduation prior to beginning eligibility for assistance. The grants may be used for tuition, room and board, fees and books. **Deadline: Applications must be postmarked by March 31, 2026.**

Society of Women Engineers Emerging First Year Scholars: The [application](#) for the 2025-2026 academic year is open. All application materials and reference letter are due by **March 31, 2026.**

Des Moines Dollars for Scholars awards scholarships for two-year, four-year, or vocational and technical colleges. Students graduating from high school who attend school in Des Moines, Washington, *or* who live in the cities of Des Moines or Normandy Park, Washington, may be eligible. Balkhi Foundation Higher Education Scholarships **Deadline: April 6, 2026**

[Great Minds in Stem](#): Applicants must be pursuing a science, technology, engineering or math degree, have an overall minimum GPA of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale for merit-based scholarships, and must be of Hispanic descent and/or must demonstrate significant leadership or service within the underserved community. **Deadline: May 8, 2026**
