Dear HPCSD CSEA Retirees:

As a CSEA retiree eligible for Medicare Part B reimbursement, you are required to send a copy of your Benefit Statement, Notice of Cost-of-Living Adjustment (COLA) or Social Security Administration Benefit Verification Letter every year, in order to document the amount the Hyde Park Central School District is responsible for reimbursing you. Auditor requirements must be met in order for the District to issue reimbursements.

This reimbursement is available for both yourself and your covered spouse. If you have not submitted your required statements for 2026 reimbursement purposes, we are requesting that you submit a copy of your 2026 benefit statement for you and your covered spouse as soon as possible.

If you do not have a copy of your 2026 benefit statement, you can obtain one from the Social Security Administration by signing in to your Social Security account online, calling them toll free at 1-800-772-1213 (TTY 1-800-325-0778), or by contacting your local SSA office.

Documents can be submitted in person, by postal mail to the address below ATTN: Human Resources-Benefits, by email to BENEFITS@HPCSD.org, or by fax to 845-229-4056 ATTN: Human Resources-Benefits. Please include your email address and/or phone number with your benefit statement so we can confirm receipt of your documents.
