**TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 25, 2025, 8:00 A.M. – 1:16 P.M.**

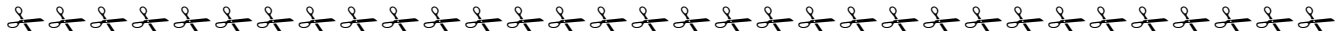
