Memorandum of Understanding
between the
Clark-Shawnee Local Board of Education
and the
Clark-Shawnee Local Education Association

This Memorandum of Understanding is entered into on this 26th day of March, 2026 (“Effective Date”) by and between the Clark-Shawnee Local Board of Education (“Board”) and the Clark-Shawnee Local Education Association (“CSLEA”) (collectively, “Parties”) for the purpose of documenting mutual agreement to allow two (2) bargaining unit employees to share one (1) FTE position of Pre-School Intervention Specialist for the 2026-2027 school year only.

WHEREAS, the Board and CSLEA are Parties to Contractual Agreement(s) effective July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2028 (“Agreement”); and

WHEREAS, Article I, Professional Negotiations Procedure, Section I, Professional Negotiations Procedure, Section A., Recognition, of the Agreement provides that the Clark-Shawnee Local Education Association is the sole and exclusive representative of full time and regular part-time certificated teachers; and

WHEREAS, Article 23, Part-Time Employment, of the Agreement addresses terms and conditions of employment pertaining to bargaining unit employees who work less than full-time, including terms and conditions of employment pertaining to insurance coverages; and

WHEREAS, Article 31, Medical Insurance, of the Agreement sets forth the terms and conditions of medical insurance offerings and contributions for bargaining unit employees who are eligible for and choose to enroll in same; and

WHEREAS, for the 2025-2026 contract year only, the Parties entered into two (2) Memoranda of Understanding (“Memoranda”) addressing the structuring the one (1) FTE Pre-School Intervention Specialist position to be split into two (2) part-time Pre-School Intervention Specialist positions for the 2025-2026 school year, with one (1) of the part-time positions being at .51 FTE and the other part-time position being at .49 FTE; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the terms of the Memoranda, the Parties agreed that CSLEA bargaining unit employee Elizabeth Avery would be employed at the .51 FTE part-time Pre-School Intervention Specialist position for the 2025-2026 school year and Julie Jennings would be employed at the .49 FTE part-time Pre-School Intervention Specialist position for the 2025-2026 school year; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the terms of the Memoranda, the Parties further agreed that CSLEA bargaining unit employee Elizabeth Avery would pay thirty percent (30%) of costs of medical insurance during the 2025-2026 contract year at the .51 part-time Pre-School Intervention Specialist position, as a one-time exception to the provisions of Articles 23 and 31 of the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Parties agree that it is in the Parties’ and the District’s best interest to extend all terms and conditions of the Memoranda to the 2026-2027 school year;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Parties agree that for the 2026-2027 school year only, the following terms and conditions will apply to the one (1) FTE Pre-School Intervention Specialist position:

1. The one (1) FTE Pre-School Intervention Specialist position will continue to be split into .51 and .49 part-time Pre-School Intervention Specialist positions for the 2026-2027 school year only;
2. The .51 and .49 part-time Pre-School Intervention Specialist positions for the 2026-2027 school year will not be posted in accordance with the provisions of Article 25, Posting of Vacancies, Assignments, and Transfers, of the Agreement;
3. The .51 part-time Pre-School Intervention Specialist position will be filled by Elizabeth Avery for the 2026-2027 school year, and the .49 part-time Pre-School Intervention Specialist position will be filled by Julie Jennings for the 2026-2027 school year. Both part-time Pre-School Intervention Specialist positions will be considered regular part-time positions for purposes of Article 1 of the Agreement. All other provisions of the Agreement applicable to part-time bargaining unit positions will apply to each position for the 2026-2027 school year, with the exception of Elizabeth Avery will pay thirty percent (30%) of costs of medical insurance during the 2026-2027 contract year at the .51 part-time Pre-School Intervention Specialist position. This is a one-time exception only to the provisions set forth in Articles 23 and 31 of the Agreement, applicable to Elizabeth Avery's .51 part-time Pre-School Intervention Specialist position only, for the 2026-2027 contract year only;

4. Both part-time Pre-School Intervention Specialists will be issued one-year limited contracts for the 2026-2027 school year only. This is an agreed-upon exception to the sequence of contract provisions set forth in Article 17 of the Agreement;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Parties acknowledge and agree that the terms of this Memorandum of Understanding (“MOU”) are non-precedent setting and do not create or establish any form or basis of past practice between the Parties as to the subject matters addressed in this MOU;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Parties agree that this MOU shall expire at the end of the 2026-2027 contract year, with no further action required by the Parties;

The Parties each affirm that the terms of this Memorandum of Understanding were agreed to voluntarily and that the terms of this Memorandum of Understanding constitute the entire scope of understanding between the Parties as to the subject matters addressed herein. The terms of this MOU shall be binding upon the Parties upon execution and proper approval by the Parties.
