Cimberly and Cameran got to enjoy the snow!



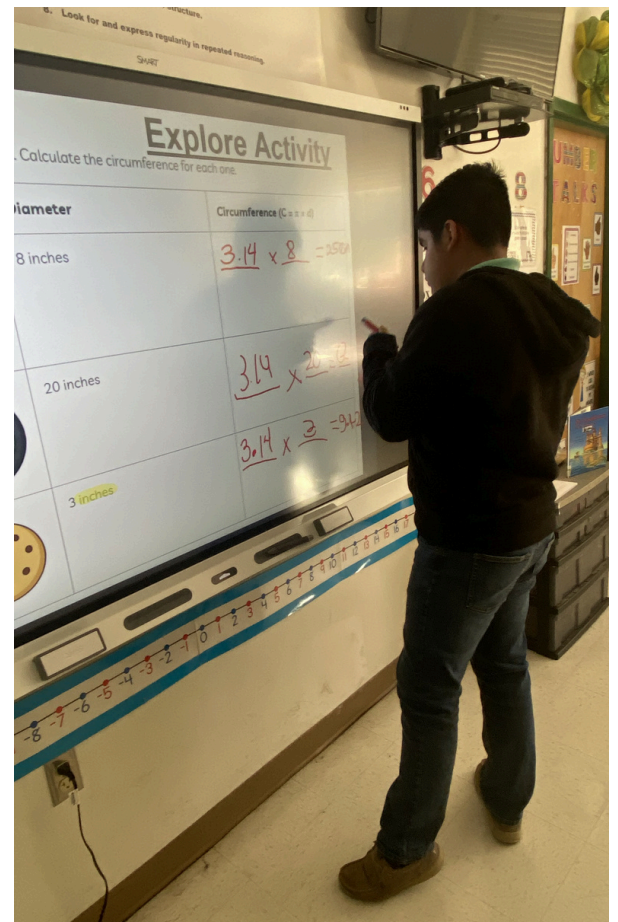
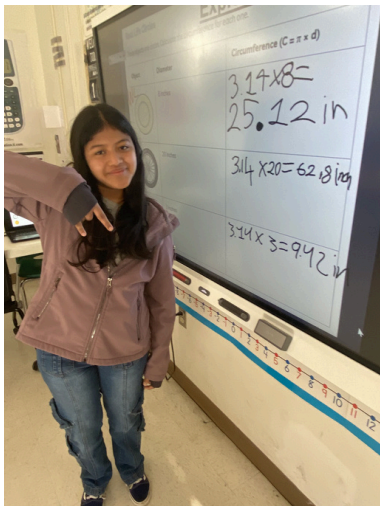
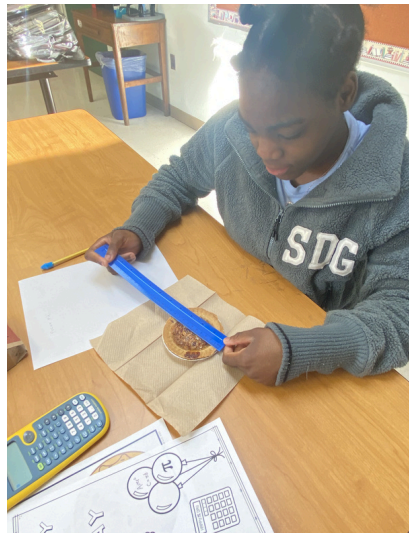
Loren and Cheryl's classes had to go outside and took a picture for the snow day!

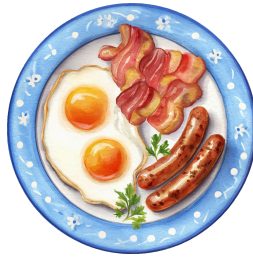
