Dear Viking Alumni,


Welcome to Archbishop Wood High School's 2018-2019 Annual Report. I am sure you will enjoy reading about what I have the blessing of witnessing on a daily basis – the achievements of Wood scholars and enhancements around our campus.

Thanks to your generous gifts, Archbishop Wood is able to help our students explore their God given talents, guide them on their paths, and find their personal missions as brothers and sisters in Christ. For example:

- Last summer seniors Billy Cook and Connor Bishop requested to have new eco-friendly water fountains put in the school. Two new eco-friendly water fountains were installed and since that time, there have been more than 40,000 plastic bottles saved
- STEM architecture students designed, raised funds for, and met with the township and the owners of the shopping center at York and Street Roads to build a much needed SEPTA bus shelter for members of the community. The project is now complete.
- Wood Junior, James Hartranft, received the St. Timothy Award, sponsored by the US National Federation of Catholic Youth Ministry for outstanding leadership to their parish or community. It is the highest form of recognition given to youth at the archdiocesan level
- Two of our juniors, Amanda Messina and Victoria Poggio, received an award for their volunteer work through the Youth Work Foundation at the Union League of Philadelphia
- When AP Environmental students learned about the decrease in the bee population, they asked for my permission to design, dig out, plant and decorate a bee and butterfly garden on campus


When you give a gift to Archbishop Wood you join the Viking Society of advancing the mission and vision of our school. The following are some of the ways you may wish to direct your gift:

# Q & A with Brandon Schmidt

## Archbishop Wood High School Alumni – Class of 2018



*My name is Brandon Schmidt and I am a proud member of the Archbishop Wood Class of 2018. I grew up and am still a member of Assumption B.V.M. Parish in Feasterville, PA. I went to Assumption B.V.M. School and then later Saint Katharine Drexel School. Now, I am a Seminarian for the Archdiocese of Philadelphia attending Saint Charles Borromeo Seminary. Some of the activities I was involved in at Wood were the Cross Country Team, TV Studio, Student Council, C.A.R.E. Program, Peer Leaders and more!*

### How did Archbishop Wood help guide your decision for your next steps after graduation?

Entering seminary certainly isn't the average career path for a high schooler. Wood offered me so many opportunities to explore my faith during my high school years. The Catholic faith certainly is the cornerstone of Archbishop Wood. It is obvious that the teachers and staff here at Wood live their faith inside and outside of their classrooms. The extraordinary campus ministry programs at Wood allowed me to really

explore my faith especially the Kairos retreats, weekly bible studies, the Liturgy Team, and more. Additional opportunities to attend confession each week and the offering of daily mass really helped me meet my spiritual needs and allowed me to experience Christ through the sacraments.



### What is one (or two) of your most memorable experiences while attending Archbishop Wood?

One of my most memorable experiences while at Wood was taking trips with the Cross Country Team. Our trips were not just to run races, but were team retreats. They were times to really just get away from the hustle and bustle of school and spend time together as a team and really get to know each other. Also, our faith was very important as a team. We would go to mass while on the trips and pray frequently.

Another one of my favorite memories was taking part in the Mr. Viking competition during my senior year. It was awesome putting together such a crazy and funny show with the guys as our time in high school was winding down. It was also fun having the opportunity to just be ourselves up on stage. Even

though we drove Mr. Mingacci nuts, we had so much fun! Winning the competition was pretty cool too!

### Who would you say has been the most influential person in your life from Archbishop Wood if you have one?

Father Paul O'Donnell is definitely the most influential person in my life from Archbishop Wood. Whenever I mention that it is him he says something like "I don't know why, I didn't really do anything." It makes me laugh. But for me that's just it, it's nothing extraordinary but it's the way he lives his everyday life. He is a holy priest who loves serving God and His people. Father Paul is usually one of the first people into the building in the morning and one of the last to leave after school. He is the moderator of so many groups at school, it's incredible! You will always see him on the field or in the bleachers cheering for the Vikings. In my opinion, he is the



most dedicated person at Archbishop Wood! A good friend of mine says it best: "Father Paul must never have a bad day because he is always smiling!" I strive to be like Father Paul if God wills me to be ordained someday.

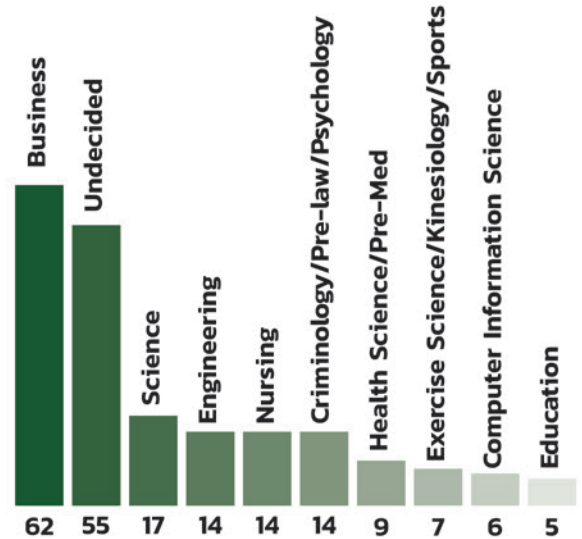

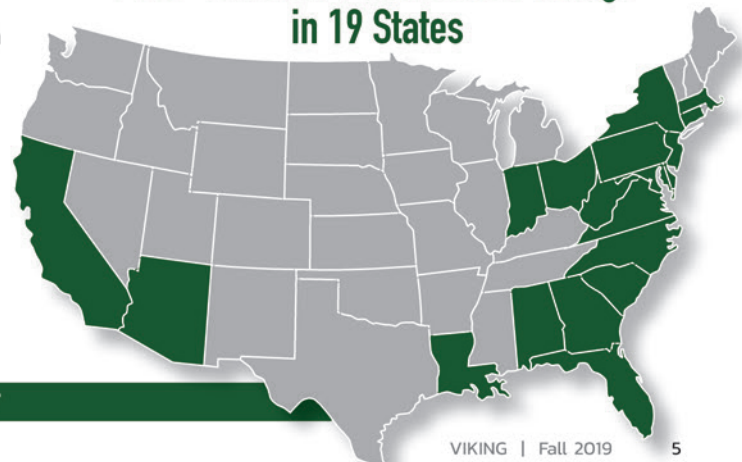

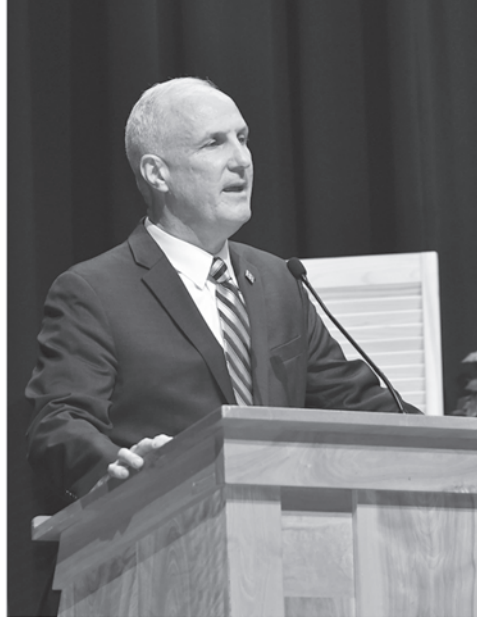

# The Michael S. Monaghan Scholarship



If Michael Monaghan of the class of 1995 were alive today, he would don a flannel and ripped jeans, toss his wavy hair to the side, put his head down and start playing guitar, most likely a song by Poison, or maybe Eric Clapton or Pink Floyd. He might tilt his head up at one point and flash his contagious smile, or he might wander over to the piano and jam out a song by Journey

or The Beatles. He most definitely would insist on a country song, maybe George Strait's "I Cross My Heart."

Sadly, Michael passed away due to a tragic Navy helicopter training accident in 1998, at the age of 21. He was a Search and Rescue crew chief who loved to work on his '72 Olds Cutlass 442, take flying lessons, play with his two cats, Stinky and Blackie, and had his hopes set on officer's school. Tragedy sparked triumph, as his brothers Bill and Jim, his family, and his friends, founded the Michael Shamus Monaghan Memorial Scholarship concert in the spirit of Michael's love for helping others and for music, celebrating its 21st year in 2019.

To date, more than \$133,000 has been awarded to more than 49 students in scholarships at Archbishop Wood High School, continuing the legacy and honoring the memory of Michael Shamus Monaghan, AWHs Class of 1995, US Navy AMH3, son, brother, friend, and hero.

Memorable moments in the history of the Monaghan Concert include The Beatles vs. Elvis (no winner); Disney Tribute with a parade of children dressed as their favorite characters; the Blues Brothers Fabulous Rhythm and Blues Revue; Thriller & Bohemian Rhapsody, both in the 2019 show and, featuring more than 25 people for each number; Armed Forces Tribute during which military members in the audience stand and receive recognition from the audience. The performers are not only top-notch talent, but also a close knit family who are reunited each year at the concert, even adopting more members of the family through the years.

Another notable achievement attributed to the longevity of the concert and the memory of Michael Monaghan is the 2019 show featured 12 Alumni performers, 3 active students, 2 Alumni on crew, and Alumna choreographer, and a new category: 15 children/nieces/nephews of Alumni!
