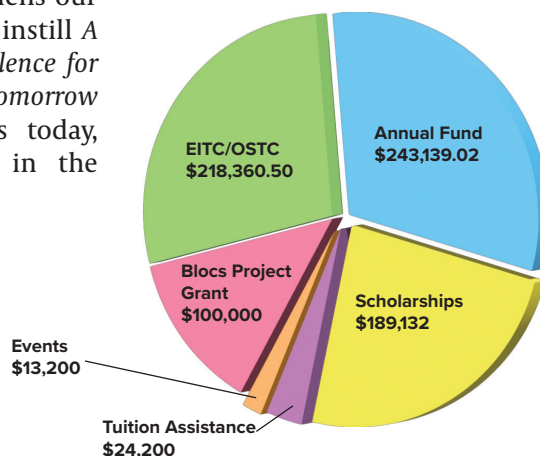

*The Pennsylvania Educational Improvement Tax Credit (EITC) and Opportunity Scholarship Tax Credit (OSTC) programs offer individuals and businesses an opportunity to receive up to a 90% tax credit against their personal PA state tax liability.*

### WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

- Individuals who pay personal income tax through an LLC, S Corp, or who own or are a member of an LLP
- Businesses authorized to do business in Pennsylvania who are subject to one or more of the following taxes:
  - Personal Income Tax
  - Corporate Net Income Tax
  - Capital Stock/Foreign Franchise Tax
  - Malt Beverage Tax
  - Bank and Trust Company Shares Tax
  - Title Insurance & Trust Company Shares Tax
  - Insurance Premium Tax (excluding surplus lines, unauthorized, domestic, foreign/marine)

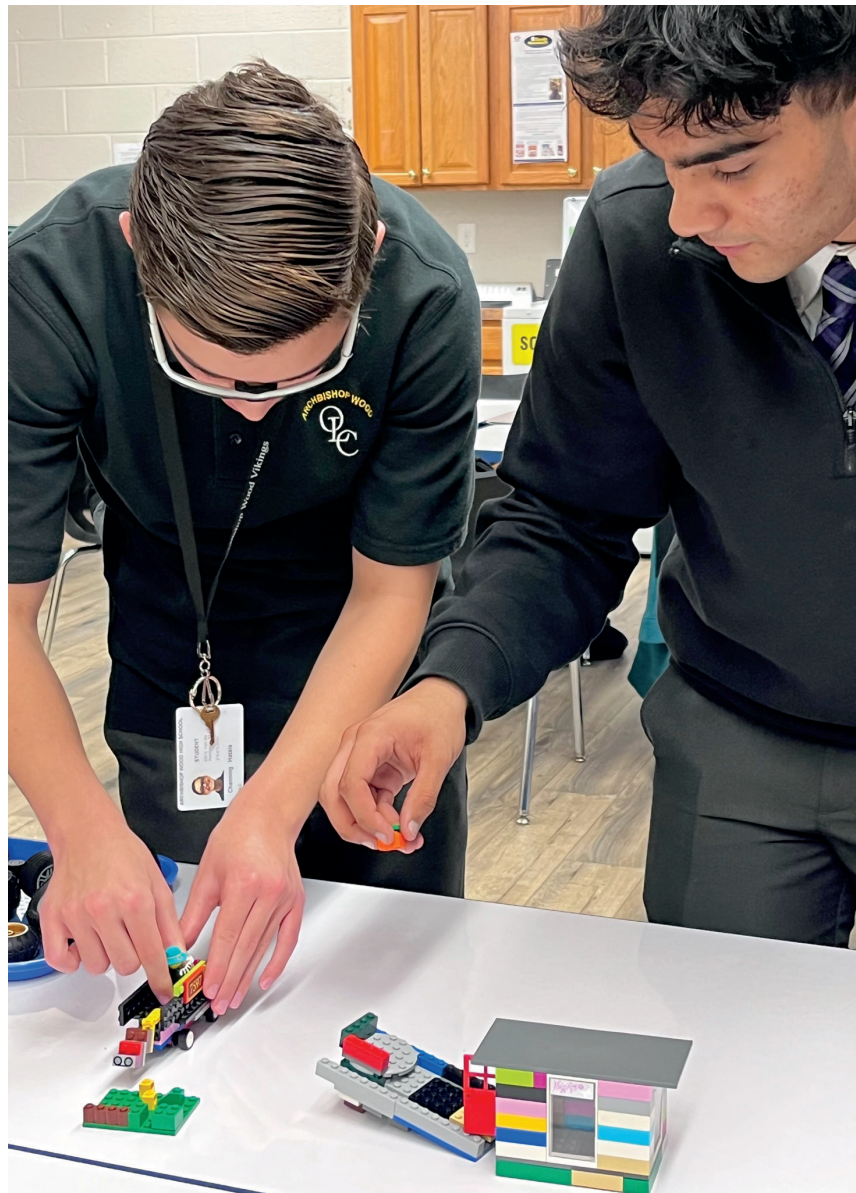

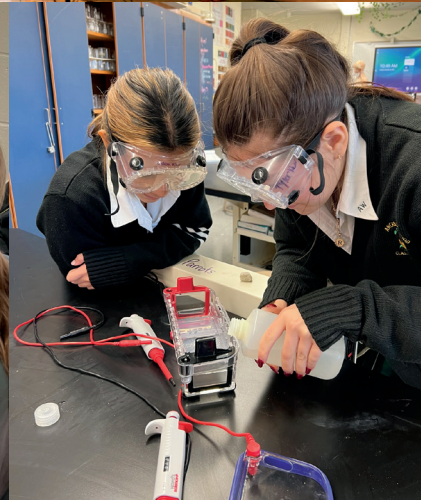
