## Admission Policy and Procedures

Clint ISD Early College Academy (CECA) is open to all students who are motivated and willing to commit to a four-year program with priority admission as follows: ☐

- First Priority: 8th grade Clint ISD students ☐
- Second Priority: 8th grade students who live within the CISD attendance area but do not attend Clint ISD schools ☐
- Third Priority: 8th grade students who live in areas other than Clint ISD

All interested 8th grade students must submit a Clint ISD Early College Academy application and participate in an interview with campus administrators. The interview is to provide information about the campus and answer any questions the students and the parents may have.

Parents are an important part of the process and need to demonstrate their support by completing the parent sections of the application and attending the student interview with their child.

There are no pre-requisites for eligibility. Students may attend CECA regardless of language proficiency, test scores, socio-economic status, gender, ethnicity/race, etc.

A student must be dedicated and committed to earning an Associate Degree or core college credit while earning a high school diploma.

Students are invited to attend based on priority tier. Students who are in the first priority tier will be placed in random lottery and names will be drawn until all applicant spaces are filled. Any students from the first priority tier who are not identified in the random lottery are placed on a waiting list. Students in the second and third priority tiers will be chosen in a random lottery if any additional applicant spaces are available. The remaining spaces will be divided so that they are divided with 70% coming from the second priority tier and 30% from the third priority tier. Any remaining names will be placed on a waiting list. The students who are identified must attend a mandatory Summer Bridge Program before the beginning of their 9th grade school year.
