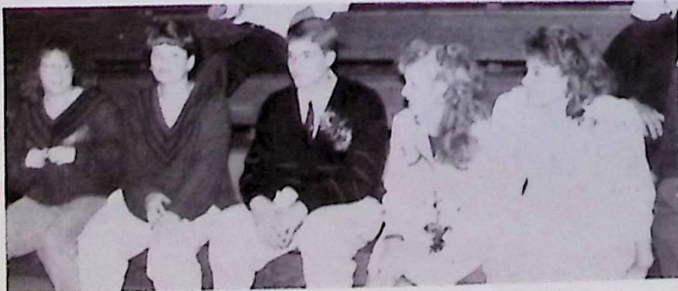
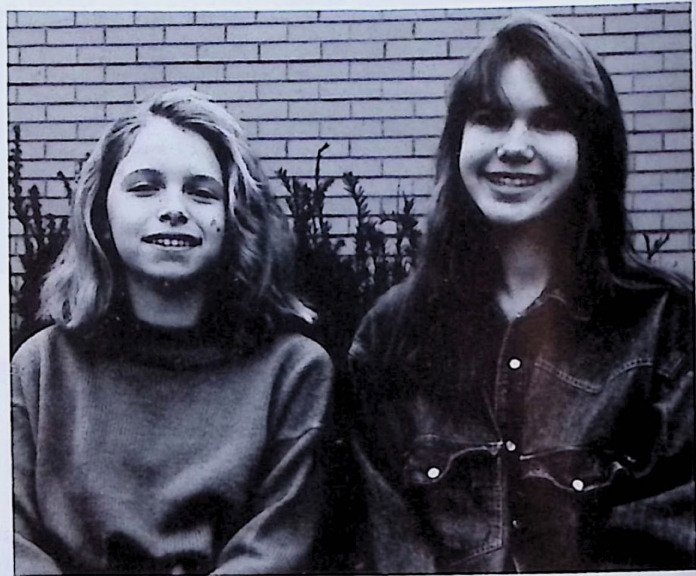
# JUST THE RIGHT MIX

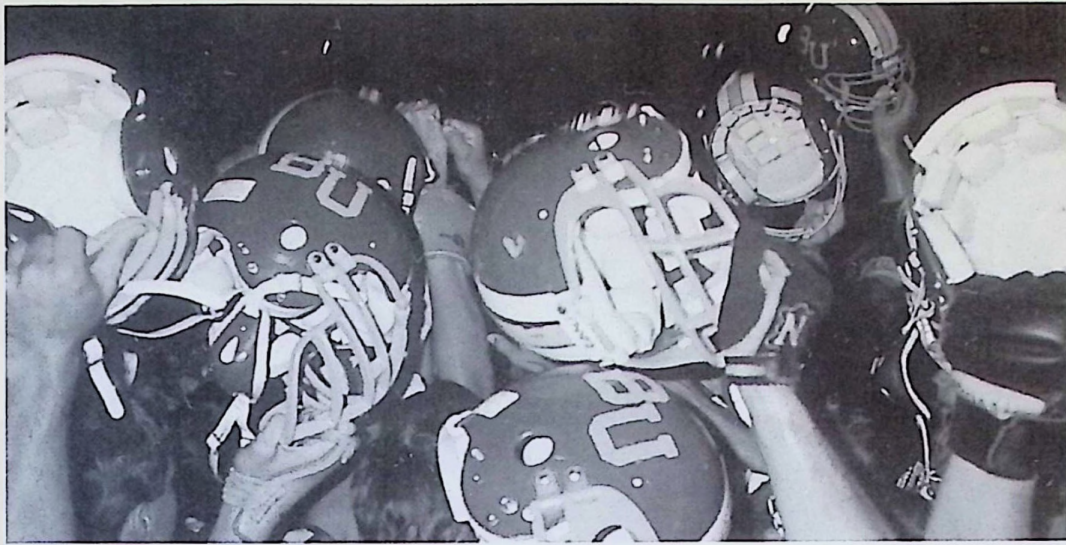

The scoreboard after the Rockets upset Amanda. 14-13, overtime.









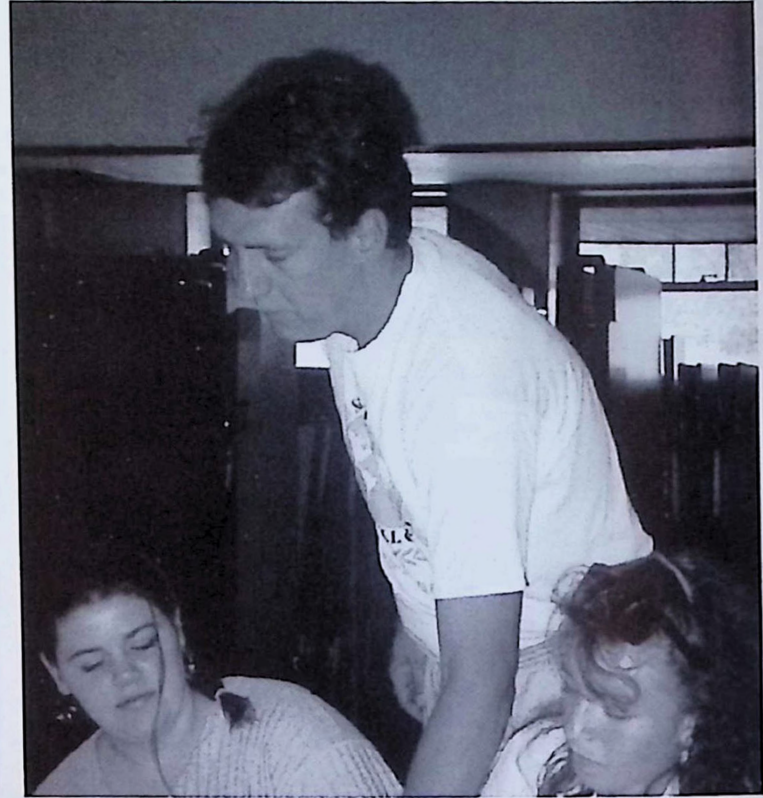

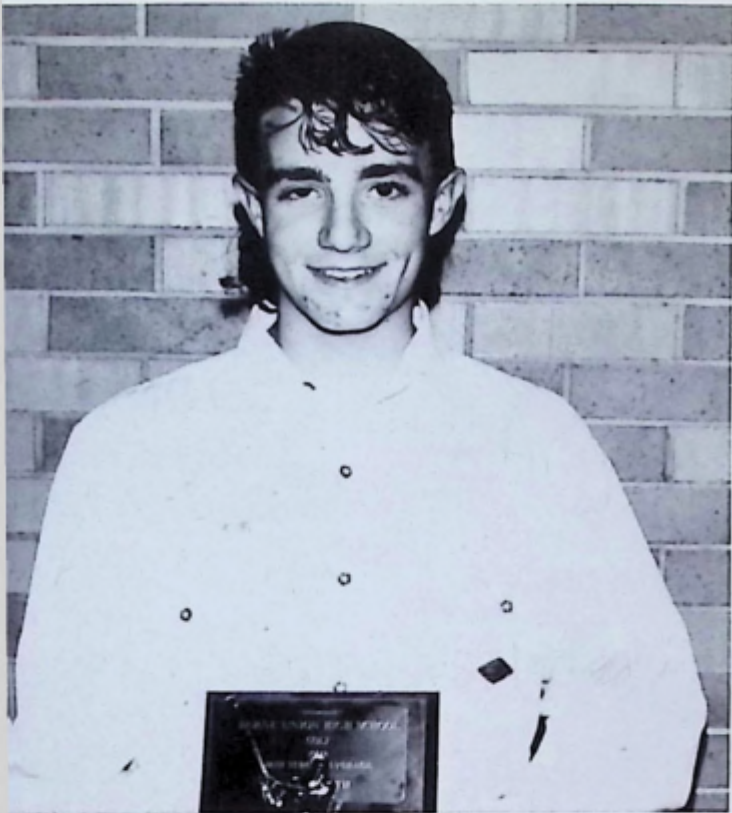
