Minutes from May 19, 2025 DLT meeting:

Preliminary Data Presentation: MCA Math shows increases in scores in the 6th, 8th and 11th grades. There were also increases in cohort proficiency in 4th, 7th, 8th and 11th grades, with significant increases in the 8th grade.

MCA reading shows increases in scores in the 3rd, 4th, and 6th grades. There were also increases in the cohort proficiency in 4th, 5th, and 6th grades.

New Preschool Curriculum by Scholastic

Continuing with UFLI with 3rd and 4th grade moving in to Morphology

Accelerated Mathematics Pathway- an acceleration procedure that allows students to advance to the next grade level of math. There are on ramps in the 5th, 6th, 8th and 9th grades. It would begin with next year's 5th grade students. See attached Information sheet.

CIS /PSEO programming: Pillager School will be partnering with Alexandria Technical and Community College. They offer Online College in the high school that are exclusively for high school students to earn dual credit. See attached information sheet.

Career Programming Activity: We worked in small groups tying our portrait of a graduate data to our Career Pathways program.
