The sealed proposals must be received **on or before 10:00 a.m. on Monday, April 13, 2026**, at which time said proposals will be publicly opened and acknowledged. The School District may select as the successful proposer that proposal which, in the School District's sole discretion and with whatever modifications the School District and the proposer may mutually agree upon, best meets the School District's requirements whether or not that proposal is the lowest priced. No proposer shall have any legal, equitable, or contractual rights of any kind arising out of its submission of a proposal. Incomplete proposals may not be considered.
