1. Narrative description of the Prop 28 arts education program(s) funded. (2500 character limit).

For the 2024-2025 school year, our district's art education programs benefited from Proposition 28 funding. Five new full-time equivalent (FTE) teaching positions were created in early November to expand out offerings in Cultural Arts, Visual Arts, Graphic Design, Vocal Music, and Graphic Art and Design. However, due to the challenge of hiring qualified staff these positions remained unfilled, and the associated funds were not expended this year. We used a varied approach to ensure students still had access to arts instruction. Certificated substitutes provided some in-class coverage, while classified employees offered hands-on assistance at school sites for about about two hours twice a week. Additionally, certificated teachers led after-school classes, providing students with opportunities to engage in visual arts, music, and design. These alternative strategies ensured that some arts instruction was still available despite the challenge of filling new positions.
