**RECOGNITION OF LESBIAN, GAY, BISEXUAL, TRANSGENDER, AND QUEER
(LGBTQ+) PRIDE MONTH
JUNE 1 – JUNE 30, 2025**

WHEREAS, "Gay and Lesbian Pride Month" was first established in June 2000 through a Presidential Proclamation, and has since evolved into what is now nationally recognized as Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender, and Queer (LGBTQ+) Pride Month; and

WHEREAS, the month of June commemorates the anniversary of the Stonewall Uprising, a pivotal event in the LGBTQ+ rights movement, which began following a police raid at the Stonewall Inn in New York City in June 1969 and brought national attention to the fight for LGBTQ+ equality; and

WHEREAS, LGBTQ+ Pride Month is a time to affirm the dignity, visibility, and contributions of LGBTQ+ individuals, to promote inclusiveness, raise awareness of ongoing challenges, take a stand against discrimination and violence, and celebrate the diversity of the community through peaceful protest and advocacy; and


WHEREAS, LGBTQ+ youth are working to build supportive and safe school environments by engaging in leadership opportunities, including participation in Gender and Sexuality Alliance (GSA) clubs, and speaking out against bullying and harassment; and

WHEREAS, California Education Code Section 51204.5 calls for the inclusion of the roles and contributions of lesbian, gay, bisexual, and transgender Americans in social science instruction, highlighting their influence on the economic, political, and social development of California and the nation, and emphasizing their impact on contemporary society;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the South San Francisco Unified School District Board of Trustees formally recognizes June 2025 as LGBTQ+ Pride Month and honors the history, contributions, and continued efforts of LGBTQ+ individuals in the advancement of equity and inclusion.


