Resolution #25-58

Recognizing October 2025 as NATIONAL BULLYING PREVENTION MONTH

WHEREAS, the South San Francisco Unified School District affirms the rights of all students and staff to attend schools that are safe and free from violence, harassment, bullying, and discrimination; and

WHEREAS, providing a safe school environment that supports both the physical and emotional well-being of students and staff creates the conditions necessary to foster academic achievement; and

WHEREAS, bullying, harassment, discrimination, and violence, and even the fear of harm can create barriers to learning and contribute to low self-esteem, depression, anger, and, in extreme cases, school violence or suicide; and

WHEREAS, a safe school is one in which teaching and learning are not disrupted, drugs and violence are absent, bullying and fear are not present, students are not subject to discrimination, expectations for behavior are clearly communicated, and consequences for infractions are applied consistently and fairly; and

WHEREAS, school districts and county offices of education have a responsibility under California law to ensure a safe school environment that is free of intimidation and harassment; and


WHEREAS, the most effective approach to building safe school environments requires a comprehensive, coordinated effort including school-wide, district-wide, and community-wide strategies, in which all institutions, organizations, and individuals accept responsibility for their roles and collaborate to establish a positive climate for teaching and learning; and


WHEREAS, the month of October is recognized nationally as Bullying Prevention Month, a campaign that raises awareness of bullying and provides schools and communities with an opportunity to educate students, families, and the public about their role in bullying prevention;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the South San Francisco Unified School District Board of Trustees hereby recognizes October 2025 as National Bullying Prevention Month.


