# Maine Central Institute Burnt Island Expedition

## June 11 - 13, 2026

*Join Hurricane Island Outward Bound in June for a special 3-day backcountry island experience available just for Maine Central Institute students!*

Step beyond the shoreline and into a unique maritime adventure.

Over three unforgettable days, Maine Central Institute students will travel to HIOBS' Burnt Island Basecamp, a remote 265-acre island four nautical miles offshore. With the support of your instructors, students will take part in island camping, meal preparation, rock climbing, solo reflection, and other activities. Once on the island, your group will also have the opportunity to gain beginner to intermediate skills in sea kayaking through guided instruction and paddles—and weather & skill permitting, may even kayak to and camp on a neighboring island. During the course of the expedition, as responsibility shifts to students, you and your peers will strengthen communication, leadership, teamwork, and belonging through shared challenge and reflection, discovering more about yourself & the world around you. Are you ready?

### Course Details:

**Day 1:** Arrive at 8:30am. Orientation, transport to Burnt, camp setup, instructor-led activities

**Day 2:** Rock climbing (weather dependent), paddle training, reflection

**Day 3:** Sea kayaking final, pack up camp, return to mainland, course end. Students depart at 4pm.
