

Pioneer-Plus Scholarship 2026

The Pioneer-Plus Scholarship is available to qualified Conestoga High School graduates after the conclusion of at least one successful year at a technical/trade school, a community college, or a 4-year college, to help cover the costs of the following year's tuition/room/board. All applicants must be well-rounded students who are committed to working hard in their schooling while also making good decisions in their everyday lives. Scholarship amounts vary, but they tend to be in the \$1000-\$3000 range. **No student can apply more than 3 times for this assistance.** To qualify for this award, the applicant must meet the requirements below:

- Earn a cumulative GPA of at least 2.75 freshman year, and 3.0 subsequent years
- Participate in at least one sports team, club or other activity while on campus
- Hold at least a part time job while on campus and during the summer
- Exhibit a need for financial assistance by having received grants from all possible financial aid sources, including FAFSA & Pell (and PHEAA if at a PA school)
- Have a clean record of suspensions or disciplinary action during the previous year in college

Qualified applicants should complete the form below and submit it to the CHS by July 15. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
