## PARISH

### The Triduum, Continued....by Dr. Kathleen DeJardin

*Continuing last week's article...a reminder that there is no formal ending to the Holy Thursday Mass of the Lord's Supper.*

The Friday of the Passion of the Lord service has three sections (not a regular Mass) and begins at 3:00pm, the hour when Jesus died on the cross. The priest wears red and prostrates after reverencing the altar. During the Liturgy of the Word, we hear the Passion according to John, which is followed by The Solemn Intercessions, ten invitations to pray for the Church and the world. These intercessions are followed by the Adoration of the Cross, the second part of this service, where we remember and reflect, through our humble adoration, on the impact of Jesus' death in our lives. The final part of this service is Holy Communion. As the altar is stripped following the Procession of the Blessed Sacrament on Thursday night, a cloth, the corporal, and the Missal are placed on the altar. During the Mass on Thursday evening, the Communion was consecrated for this service, and the Deacon brings the Blessed Sacrament to the altar. Following Communion, all are invited to bow low for the blessing. After genuflecting to the cross in silence, all leave.

The Easter Vigil in the Holy Night, the mother of all vigils, begins with us, the faithful, awaiting the return of the Lord with lighted candles. The Vigil begins at the Bell Tower with the Blessing of the Fire, the newly inscribed paschal candle bearing the light of Christ. The paschal proclamation, *the Exultet*, is sung and is followed by the Liturgy of the Word, which narrates our salvation history. We sing a jubilant Gloria with the ringing of bells, and the Litany of the Saints, who support us. We bless the new baptismal waters and celebrate the Baptism, Confirmation, and First Eucharist of the Elect, who are now neophytes, fully initiated into the Catholic Church and beginning a period of mystagogy, a deeper instruction in the faith and their new life as "a new creation, clothed in Christ." We are all renewed over these three days as we journey through life, death, and resurrection.

*He is risen, indeed! Alleluia! Alleluia! Alleluia!*

## DOMINGO DE RAMOS/DE LA PASIÓN (MARZO 29 DE 2026)

Hoy caminamos con Jesús rumbo al Monte Calvario. Con Su muerte en la Cruz, todos pudimos experimentar el amor abnegado que El siente por nosotros. Nosotros también hemos sido llamados a imitarle. San Francisco de Sales comenta:

Contraria a la sabiduría de la cultura, los verdaderos cristianos que buscan la santidad depositan toda su perfección en la locura de la Cruz. Todos los santos se hicieron sabios en su locura por seguir a Jesús. Ellos padecieron las humillaciones y el desprecio de los eruditos, los concedores de la cultura. Aun así, ellos lavaron sus pies y sus manos en las aguas sagradas del perdón. Nosotros también debemos limpiar nuestras obras, y nuestros afectos, para poder glorificar a Dios.

Tal y como lo hicieron los Santos, debemos ir al Monte Calvario con nuestro Señor, pasar trabajos, y soportar persecuciones. Cuando los problemas externos e internos se apoderen de ustedes, tomen sus buenas resoluciones y, como lo haría una madre que rescata a su hijo del peligro, deposítenlas sobre las heridas de nuestro Señor y pídanle que los proteja, tanto a ustedes como a ellas. Quédense allí en el resguardo sagrado, y esperen hasta que la tormenta haya pasado. Con la ayuda de Dios progresarán bastante. Como nos demuestra Jesús, el hecho de que podamos pecar no significa que tenemos poder, por el contrario, significa que hemos quedado indefensos. Incluso las persecuciones que Jesús tuvo que soportar a manos de sus enemigos, no fueron lo suficientemente poderosas como para destruir el amor constante e incomparablemente sólido que Nuestro Salvador siente por todos nosotros. Así mismo debe ser el amor que hemos de tener los unos por los otros: firme, fervoroso, sólido y perseverante.

Cuando accedemos a amar de forma divina, deshaciéndonos de nuestra voluntariedad, nos asemejamos a los pájaros que emigran. Entonces emigramos de un mundo invernal, en el que encontramos corazones fríos, gélidos, a la primavera donde el amor de Dios es el sol que calienta al corazón humano. Este Fuego Sagrado nos llena de un amor infinito y totalmente entregado. Este amor jamás dirá: “Bastante es suficiente”. Nuestro Salvador nos ama con un amor tan fervoroso y perseverante, que incluso la muerte no consiguió enfriarlo. El amor divino es más fuerte que la muerte. Ojalá que permanezcamos siempre al pie de la Cruz de Nuestro Salvador para poder alimentarnos de Su amor abnegado, el cual hemos sido llamados a imitar.

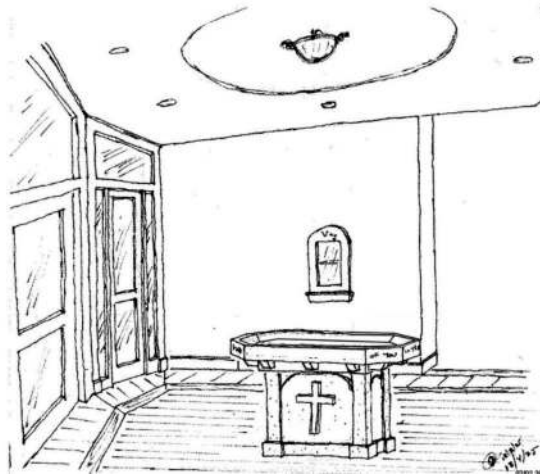
