Abbie Hughes Scholarship and Lamar Awards

Each year, Harmony Lodge No. 6 awards scholarships in honor of two late members, Bro. Roy (Abbie) Hughes and Bro. Mirabeau B. Lamar, to Galveston Area students during their senior year of High School or while in college. **THE DEADLINE TO APPLY FOR EITHER SCHOLARSHIP IS APRIL 13, 2026.** All information submitted will be held in confidence and used solely for the purpose of scholarship administration.

Guidelines and Instructions:

1. Lamar Awards can only be granted to High School Seniors and/or Educators.
2. Include a copy of your High School or College Transcript. *An official transcript is not required by preferred.*
3. Complete all information. Failure to do so may result in elimination.
4. Complete Media Consent Form.
5. Former Lamar Award recipients may reapply but will only be eligible for the Abbie Hughes Memorial Scholarship.
6. Former recipients of the Abbie Hughes Memorial Scholarship and/or Lamar Award may reapply provided they are enrolled at least half-time (*as defined by the U.S. Department of Education*) in an accredited institute of higher education while maintaining a minimum 3.0 GPA.
7. Award winners will be selected by **April 20, 2026.** **Award winners will be contacted via email and/or phone.**
8. Award winners will be invited to attend a recognition dinner to celebrate their accomplishments.

About:

Bro. Roy (Abbie) Hughes Masonic career began at Harmony Lodge No. 6 in 1956, where he actively served until his death in 2021. He served as Worshipful Master in 1977 and District Deputy in 1992. Bro. Hughes was also a member of DeMolay while attending Ball High School in 1950, served on the Board of Assembly No. 9 Order of Rainbow for Girls, and joined the El Mina Shrine Temple in 1962.

Bro. Mirabeau B. Lamar is regarded as the *Father of Texas Education*. A founding member of Harmony Lodge No. 6 in 1840, Bro. Lamar served as the second President of the Republic of Texas. While President, Bro. Lamar passed the first law mandating public education, convincing the legislature to appropriate land in every Texas county to support public schools and 50 leagues of land for two universities. The two universities would eventually become The University of Texas and Texas A&M University.
