health office. I am here to help you and your student(s) with any health needs while they are at school.

Illnesses

-If your child is ill with a fever or has gastrointestinal symptoms (vomiting and/or diarrhea), they must be symptom free for 24 hours without the use of symptom-reducing medication for 24 hours- this also includes if your child is sent home with these symptoms. They must remain home from school the next day.

-If your child tests positive for covid, influenza, RSV, etc, they must remain fever free from 24 hours with improving symptoms for 24 hours without the use of symptom-reducing medications

-If your child is ill with a contagious bacterial illness, such as strep throat or conjunctivitis, they must be on antibiotics for 12 hours prior to returning to school. For other illnesses, such as hand, foot, and mouth, please contact me via phone or email for guidance.

Restrictions

-If your student has recently been to the doctor with a sprain, broken bone or surgery please send a copy of the discharge instructions via email so any restrictions can be passed along to teachers to keep your student safe while at school.

Allergies

-If your child has a life threatening allergy that you have not already notified the school about, please notify me as soon as possible.

-If your child requires emergency medications (EpiPens/Benadryl) to be kept at school please make sure the health office has your student's medicine in case of an emergency.

Classroom Celebrations/Food Items

-In order to maintain the safety of our staff and students with medical conditions and food allergies, unsolicited food items will not be allowed in our building. If your child's teacher is planning a celebration with food items, they will reach out to their families with the necessary items.

How to tell if it's Allergies or a Cold?

- ❖ **Allergies:** Sneezing, itchy/watery eyes, clear nasal discharge, no fever.
- ❖ **Colds:** Thicker mucus, possible fever, body aches, fatigue, usually resolve in 7–10 days.

👉 **When in doubt: Reach out to your child's pediatrician for support.**

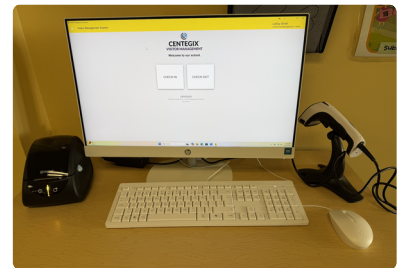
