



Ladies of the 2027 Class, check out this awesome scholarship opportunity! The P.E.O. **STAR Scholarship** awards **\$2500** to exceptional high school senior women. Application is due by August 25, 2026. This is a non-renewable \$2500 scholarship for graduating high school senior women which must be used in the academic year following graduation. This scholarship is awarded based on academic excellence, leadership, involvement and service. At the discretion of the recipient, funds may be paid directly to the recipient or to the accredited educational institution.

A woman is eligible to be recommended for the P.E.O. STAR Scholarship provided she:

- Exhibits excellence in leadership, academics, extracurricular activities, community service and potential for future success
- Is in the final academic year of her secondary education and is 20 years of age or under at the end of the calendar year
- Has a minimum cumulative unweighted GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale
- Is a citizen or legal permanent resident of the United States or Canada
- Plans to attend an accredited postsecondary educational institution in the United States or Canada, full-time or Part-time, in the fall of the academic year following high school graduation
- Is recommended by and receives the vote of a local P.E.O. chapter

- Personal Resume, detailing activities, leadership positions and community service
- A one-page essay (@700 words) articulating and discussing your (potential) career goals
- Unofficial High School Transcript (end of junior year)
- Information received will be reviewed by a local committee. Candidate may be asked to complete additional application as a national committee makes final selections.
