## Transportation:

Bus transportation is available to students, K-12, at “community stops”. Students are not picked up at individual homes, but rather centrally located stops throughout Huntersville, Cornelius and Mooresville. PLP runs **10 morning routes** and **14 afternoon routes**, which are staggered specific to the dismissal times of the Lower, Middle and Upper Schools. There is a wait list for some routes and current year riders are given priority to sign up for seats next year. We will begin setting up routes for next year in May. A survey noting your interest will be emailed at that time.

Pine Lake does not have a cafeteria. Families may order lunches online through a designated vendor one month ahead of time. Email alerts will be sent to families when the ordering window is open. Students may opt to pack lunches from home. Students eat lunch in designated classrooms or outside in the immediate vicinity of our buildings (Middle and Upper School). There are designated classrooms that are nut- or other allergen-free at all grade levels.

## Uniforms:

Pine Lake Prep requires uniforms for all students. Students wear polos and uniform bottoms Monday-Thursday. Spirit-wear (PLP-logoed tee shirt) with uniform bottoms on Friday.

Parents may purchase uniforms from Lands’ End or local vendor indicated on the website.

**Uniform bottoms** (khaki or navy pants, shorts, or skorts), may be purchased from any store, such as Old Navy, Gap, American Eagle, Children’s Place, etc.

Physical Education P.E. uniforms are optional for students in Kindergarten through grade 2. Students in grades 3 and older must wear P.E. uniforms on days they have the class. Lower School students (K-5) have P.E. once weekly and may stay in their P.E. clothes all day. Middle and Upper School students wear P.E. clothes just for class, and change into regular uniforms for the rest of the day.
