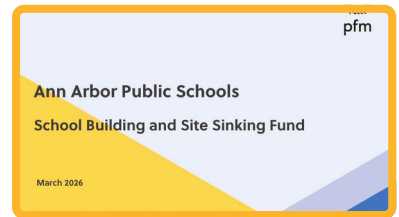

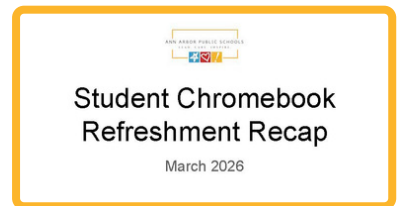
## Sinking Fund Millage Presentation

As part of the **Student Chromebook Device Refresh** recommendation discussion, Dr. Kellstrom provided information about technology usage, equity and access.



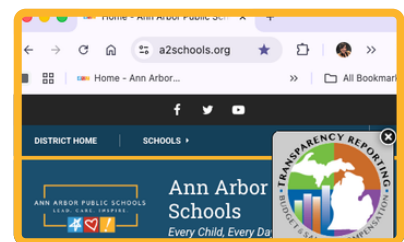
## Welcome Anté Britten - AAPS Chief Financial Officer
