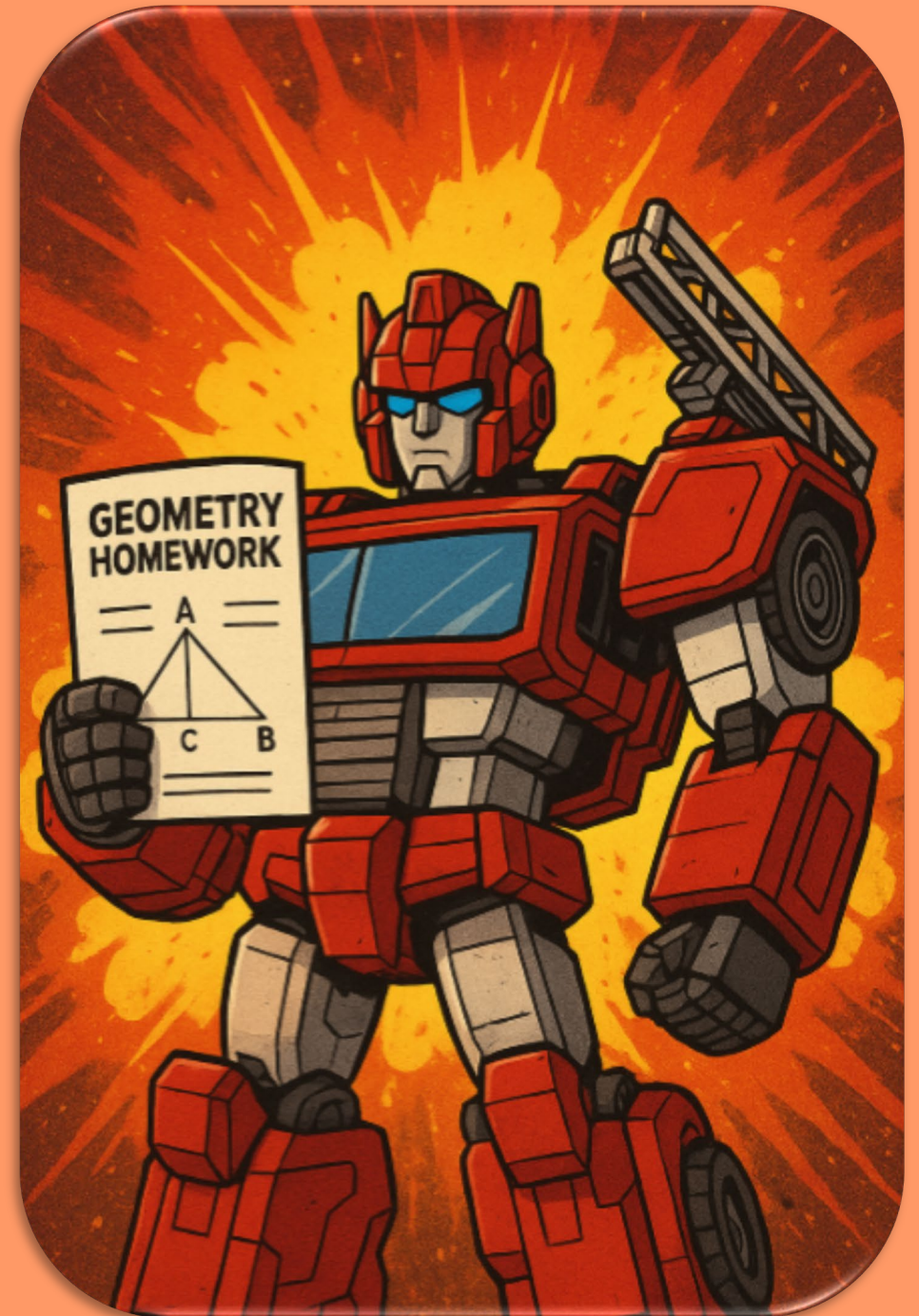

NEED TO TAKE FIRST LUNCH Tuesday and Thursday.

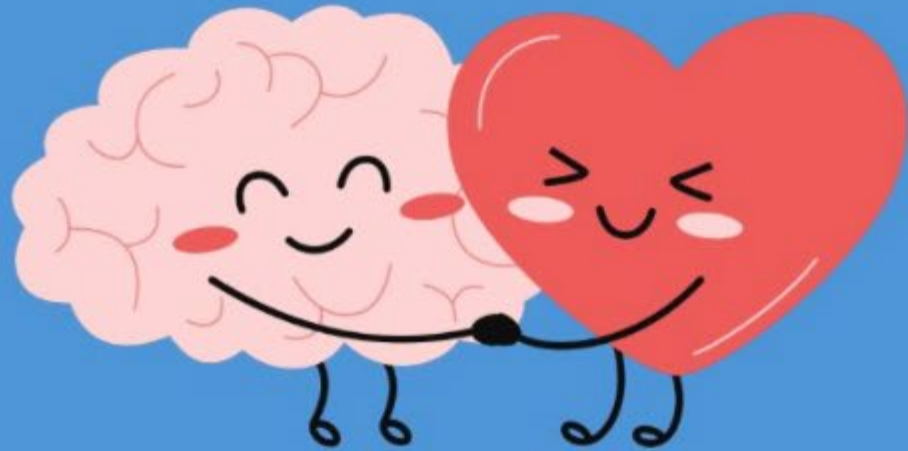
Students in **7th period world language classes**
