The Taft School seeks a head coach for the varsity boys' soccer team for a fall 2026 start date. This role can be combined with any of the full-time teaching vacancies for the 2026-2027 academic year. This is an excellent opportunity to work with students from around the world, gain valuable experience at a leading independent school, as well as to live and work in a supportive professional environment.

Soccer-related duties include:

- Coaching games and practices;
- Designing practice plans;
- Coordinating responsibilities with assistant coach(es);
- Supporting college placement for student-athletes;
- Collaborating with the Taft admissions office and college counseling office; and
- Communicating with various stakeholders, including families.

Specific qualifications include:

- Previous high-level coaching experience;
- Strong interpersonal, communication, and professional skills; and,
- A desire to work with engaged and motivated student-athletes.

- A bachelor's degree and at least three years of relevant experience;

In addition to leading the boys' soccer program, the successful candidate will serve as a full-time member of the school's faculty, perform evening duties, and participate in a second season of the school's afternoon program.
