SUMMARY OF THE POSITION:

Marquette University High School is currently seeking a qualified individual to serve as the Head Debate Coach. The Head Debate Coach promotes enrollment and retention of students in a comprehensive, nationally competitive interscholastic debate program including managing all aspects of the day-to-day coaching of students in Policy, Lincoln-Douglas, and Public Forum debate. The successful applicant will demonstrate a commitment to multiculturalism, diversity, and inclusive excellence and an ability to work with students and colleagues from diverse backgrounds.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Required duties include:

- Recruiting, retaining, and evaluating members of the debate team.
- Registers, manages, coaches, and mentors members of the team.
- Travels with students and manages all logistics related to student participation in tournaments, including approximately 20 competitions per year. This includes making travel arrangements and supervision for out-of-state tournaments.
- Supervises and coordinates student research and preparation.
- Hires and directs a staff of assistant coaches.
- Represents Marquette in state and national organizations.
- Hosts and manages the Hilltopper Classic.

Preferred skills include:

- Previous debate coaching experience.
- Experience managing a budget.
- Demonstrated ability to work collaboratively.
- Strong interpersonal, verbal and written communication skills.
- Hold an understanding of and appreciation for Jesuit education.
