Why Advanced Placement (AP) Courses?

Our AP classes give students the chance to engage in rigorous, college-level learning experiences that prepare them for academic success beyond high school.

Benefits of Taking AP Courses

Through participation in AP courses, students will:

- Build the skills needed to earn a qualifying AP Exam score of **3 or higher**.
- Develop independent thinking by analyzing information and drawing evidence-based conclusions.
- Strengthen key academic skills such as time management, organization, problem-solving, and critical thinking.

Students who self-enroll in an AP course—based on their PSAT score range or final course average, and without a teacher recommendation—acknowledge the rigor and expectations of AP coursework and understand they **cannot be removed from the class after August 10, 2026**

Summer Assignment Requirement

All AP students will complete a summer assignment to prepare for AP-level instruction.

- **Start Date:** May 26, 2026
 - **Submission Deadline:** August 3, 2026 (First Day of School)
 - **Minor Assignment Post Date:** August 28, 2026

AP Classroom & Exam Registration

All AP students will be enrolled in **AP Classroom** and will be committed to taking the **AP Exam** in May 2027.

Course Drop Expectation

- AP course removal will not be permitted on/after August 10, 2026. In extenuating situations, a review meeting will be held to carefully evaluate the circumstances and determine whether the student meets the criteria for removal.
