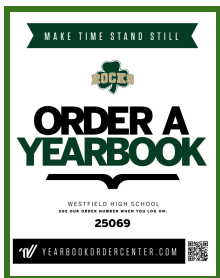

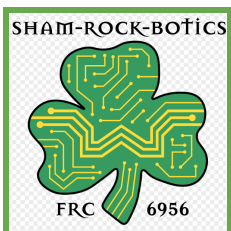
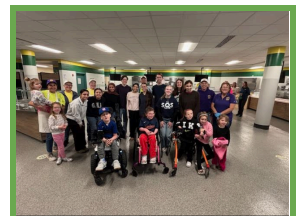
ATHLETICS:

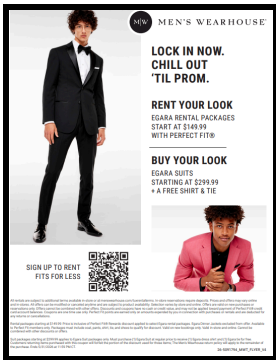
