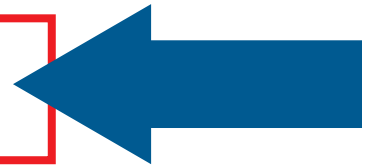


# EPIC! Connection

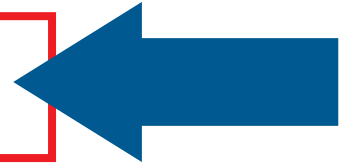

## FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

Consider the following information and assistance for those who qualify:

- You do not have to sign up for all 5 days a week at EPIC Connection. You can sign up for as many, or as few, days per week as you would like.

Below is a summary of the Minnesota Child Care Assistance Program and other programs that may be available to help.

### MINNESOTA CHILD CARE ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

There are two ways to apply for child care assistance:

Apply online at [MNbenefits.mn.gov](http://MNbenefits.mn.gov). The application is available in English, Hmong, Russian, Somali, Spanish and Vietnamese.

Fill out the Minnesota Child Care Assistance Program Application. Mail or bring the completed form to the county or tribal human services office, or local contracted agency.

### CHILDCARE PROGRAMS FOR MILITARY FAMILIES

There are several child care programs available for military families. Some are specific to a branch of service, others are for all branches. These programs include:

- Military Child Care in Your Neighborhood
- Operation: Military Child Care
- Give Army Parents a Break

These programs are administered by Child Care Aware of America.
