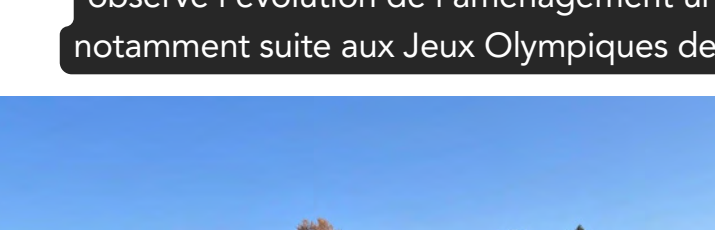

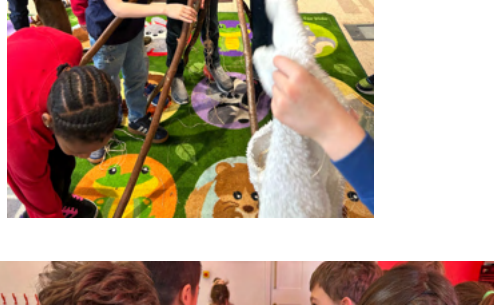

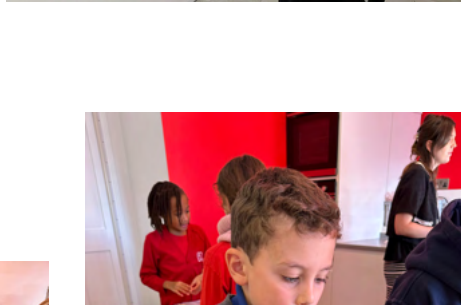

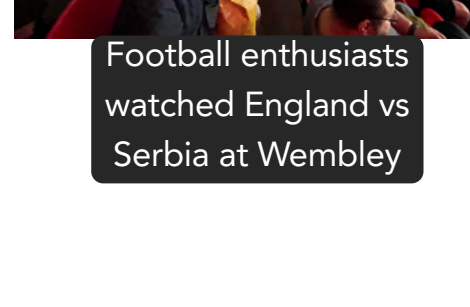

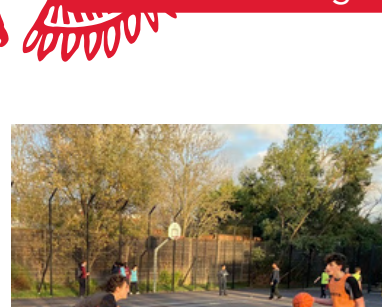

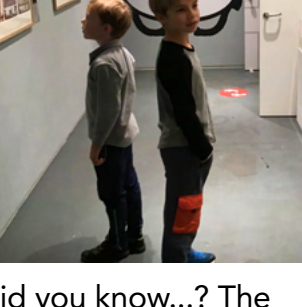

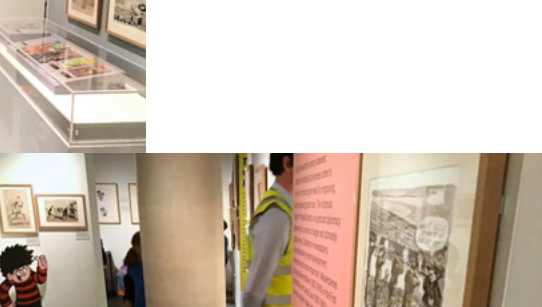

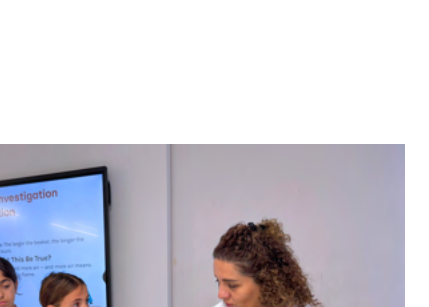

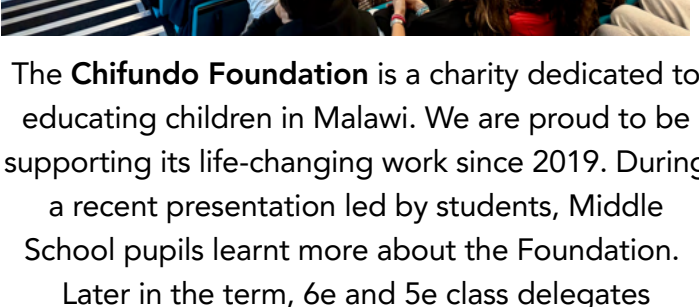
### Remembrance Day

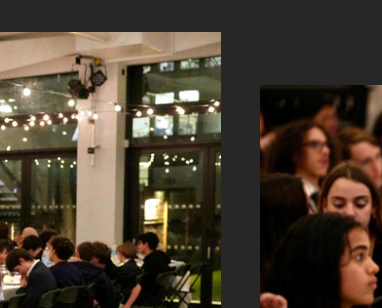

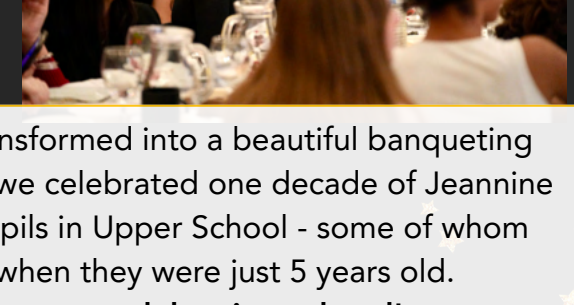
