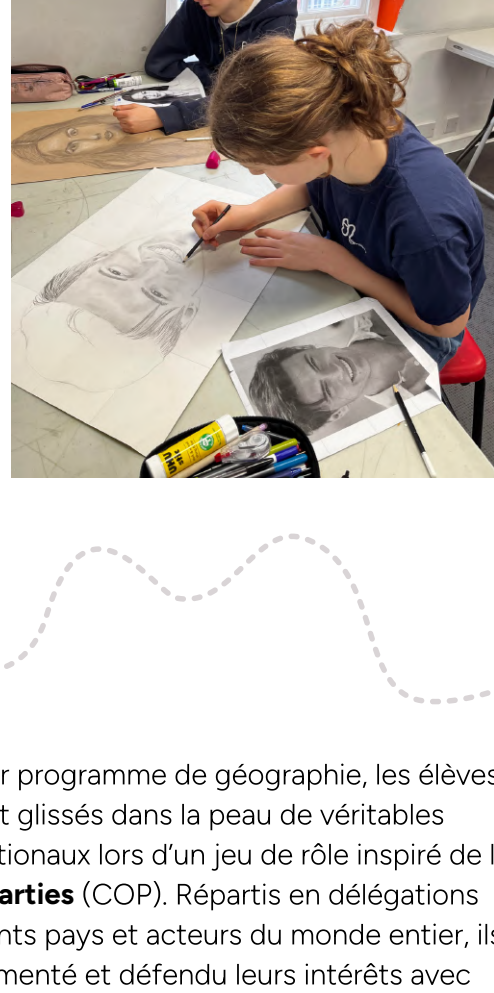

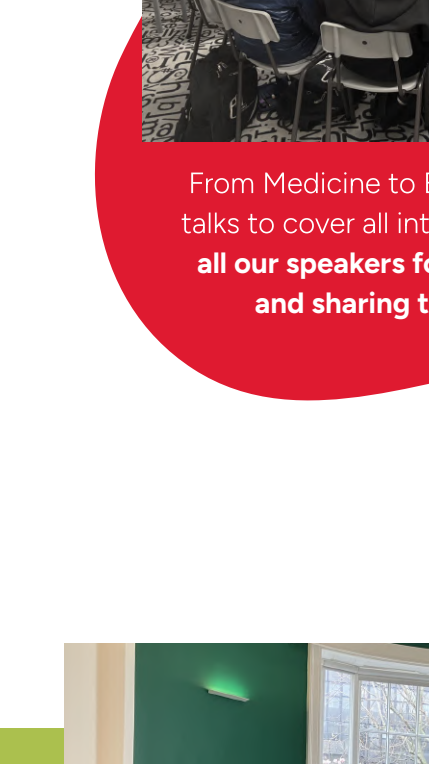
Year 8: Orchestra comes to life at the Barbican!

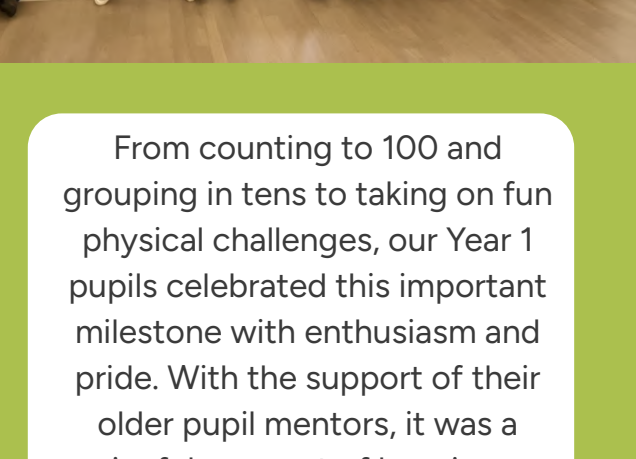
South Ken children's festival

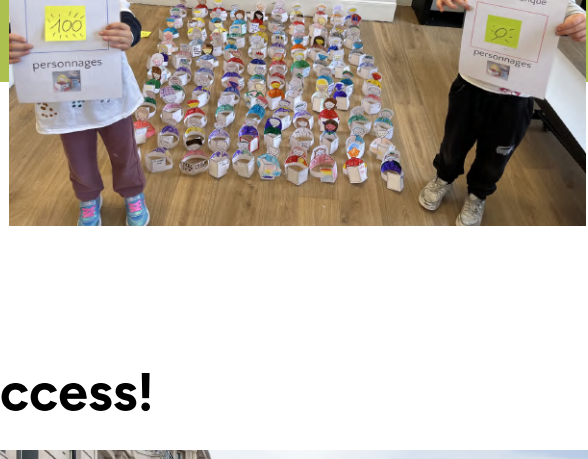
From guinea pigs to alpacas, sheep to goats - Reception class met them all on their exciting trip to Vauxhall City Farm!

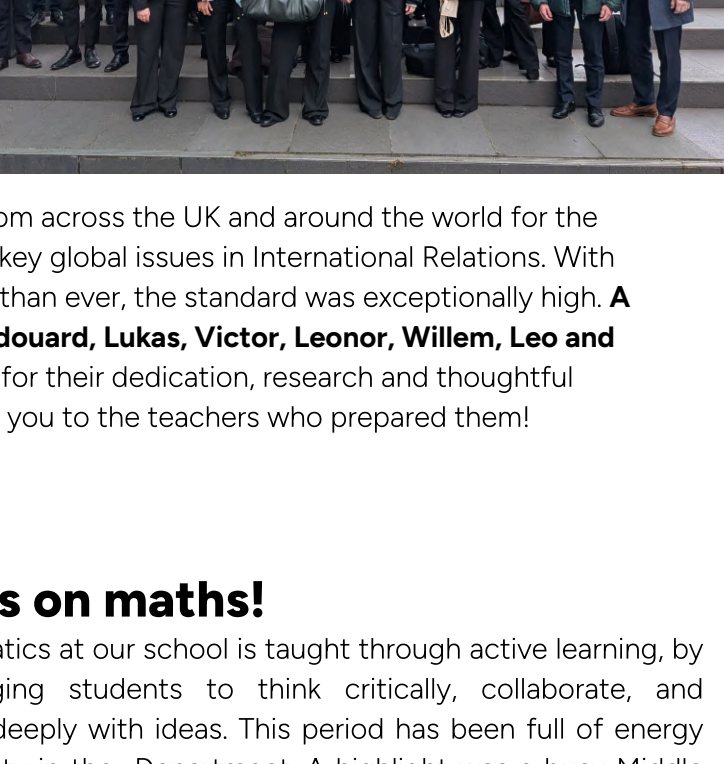

Highlight on... 100 Days of School

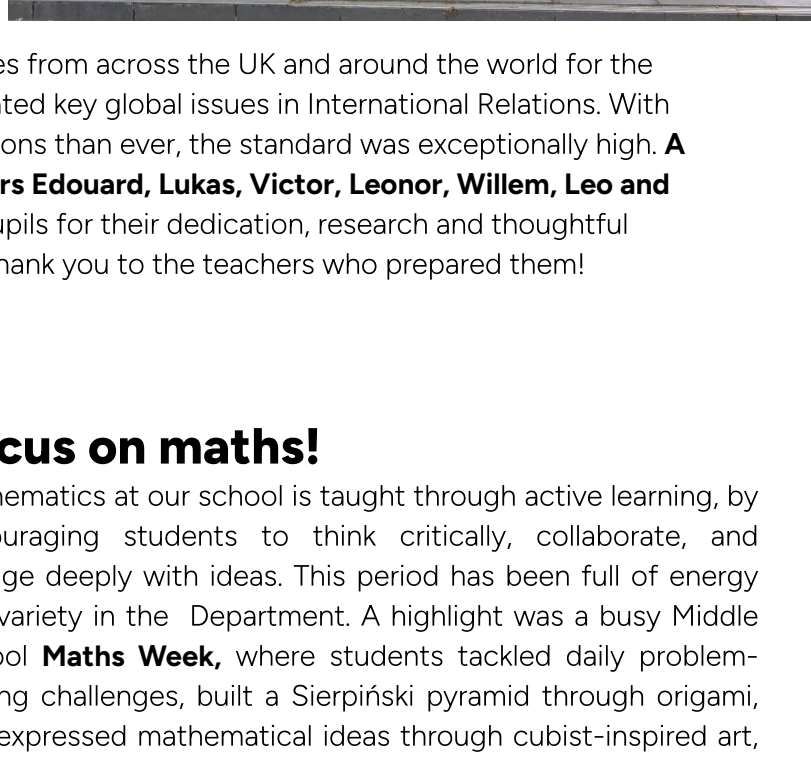
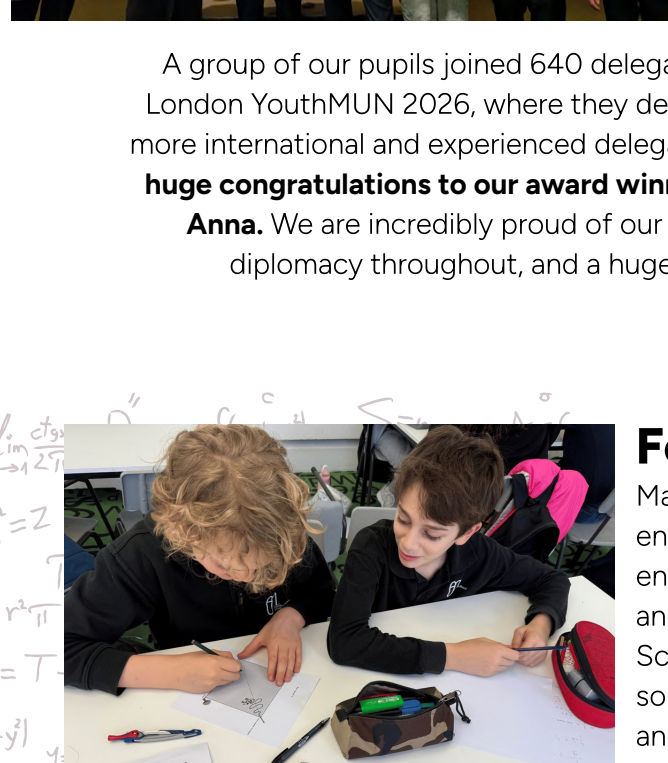
Did you know? La fête du 100 marks 100 days of learning since the start of the school year!

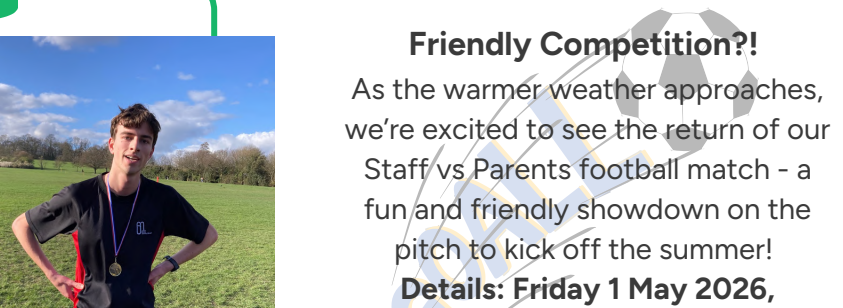
Model UN success!

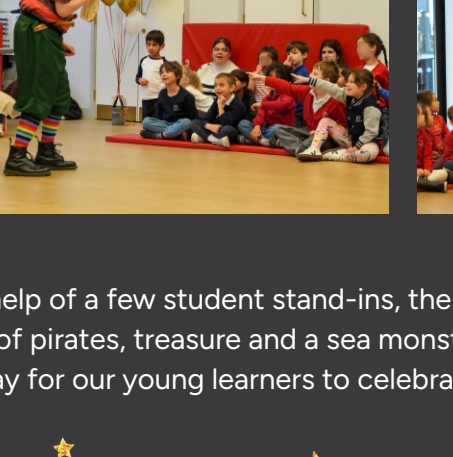
Friendly Competition?!

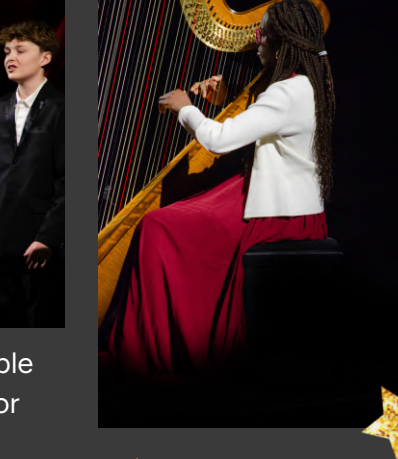
March is an exciting time for our **beehive** with the bees gathering nectar! It's all buzzing with energy as the hive is waking up for a busy season ahead!

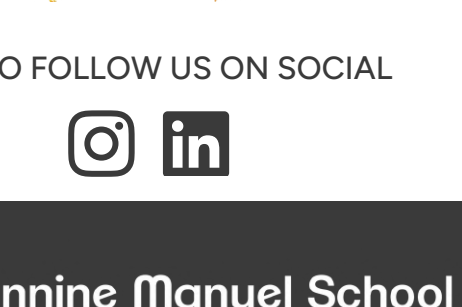


EYFS celebration!
