Selection Criteria and Recommendations:

The goal is to award qualified applicants according to their needs and worthiness.

Instructions for Applicants:

1. Read the guidelines carefully.
2. Submit a personal essay of no more than 500 words that is preferably hand written. The personal essay is to reflect your goals, motivation, reasons why you should be awarded the scholarship and an introduction of yourself to the committee who will review your application.
It should also address the questions of:
 - a). Personal ethics
 - b). Personal academic goals
 - c). The essay should demonstrate your writing ability.
3. For high school seniors - deliver your application and required materials to your scholarship counselor - and it must be received Greenville United Methodist Church no later than April 7th.
4. For non-high school students - all material and completed application forms must be mailed with your name, address and telephone number clearly marked on the application to Greenville United Methodist Church, PO Box 250, Greenville, Virginia 24440 no later than April 7th.
5. An official transcript(s) must also be included for post-high school coursework.

Eligible Requirements:

1. There shall be no age restrictions. The applicant must be a graduating high school senior, have already graduated or earned their GED.
2. The applicant must have applied to his/her school of choice and must provide documentation of acceptance before an award is confirmed.
3. The scholarship shall be delivered to the recipient.
