



Good Neighbor Policy

It is of the utmost importance that we maintain good relations with our neighbors. The Conditional Use Permit (CUP), under which we operate in a residential neighborhood, regulates our hours and imposes various restrictions that are designed to protect our neighbors. We honor the restrictions below, and beyond this, we recognize that it is part of Flintridge Sacred Heart's mission to teach and foster the values of good citizenship. We require **EVERY** member of our community – parents, students, faculty and staff alike to always observe this Good Neighbor Policy.

- Observe and obey all traffic laws in the neighborhood. Law enforcement may be asked to monitor and enforce school traffic to preserve the safety of school and neighboring communities.
- Slow down and do not tailgate drivers. Tailgating creates anxiety for motorists, which can cause accidents. If you are being tailgated, consider pulling over and letting the motorists pass. You are encouraged to report tailgating to our Campus Safety Department.
- Accommodate neighbors exiting their driveway, or entering traffic from a cross street, by safely stopping and allowing them to enter.
- Use a route other than the "Pasadena route" (Highland to Inverness to Corona to St. Katherine) to travel to/from school to help distribute traffic more evenly among our neighbors.
- Refrain from unnecessarily honking your horn, or playing car music too loud.
- Do not park on neighboring streets. Off-campus parking is enforced, where student detention and fees may apply.
- Keep the neighborhood clean and free of litter.
