ADMINISTRATIVE POLICY 4.02 BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS

(1) The Board shall have general charge of all building repairs, alterations, and improvements, as well as the improvement of grounds.

(2) The superintendent or his/her designee shall have day-to-day responsibility for the care, custody, and safekeeping of all school property.

(3) The director of the Division of Facilities and Maintenance shall be either a registered architect or a registered professional engineer in the State of Wisconsin. If not registered at the time of hire, the director must become registered within 18 months of hire. In addition, a degree in construction, engineering, architecture, design, or equivalent is highly recommended.
