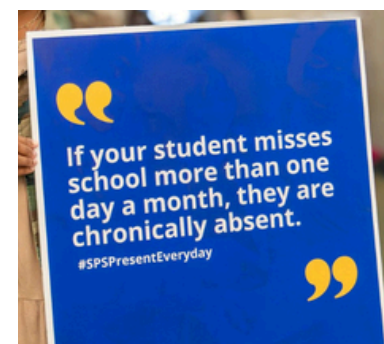
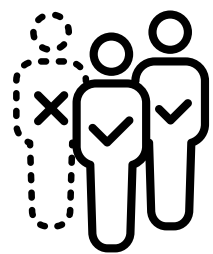
Attendance Matters!

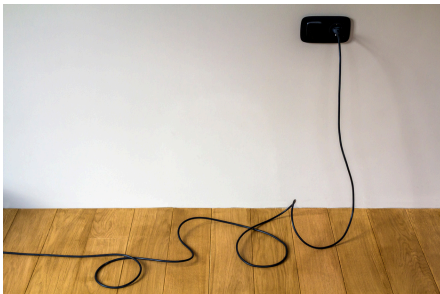

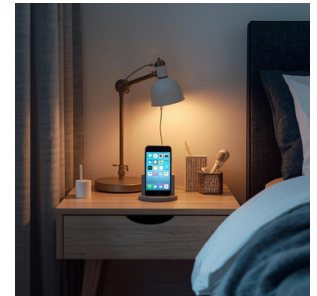

CHARGE CHROMEBOOKS NIGHTLY!



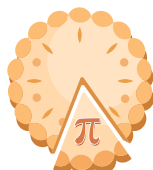
