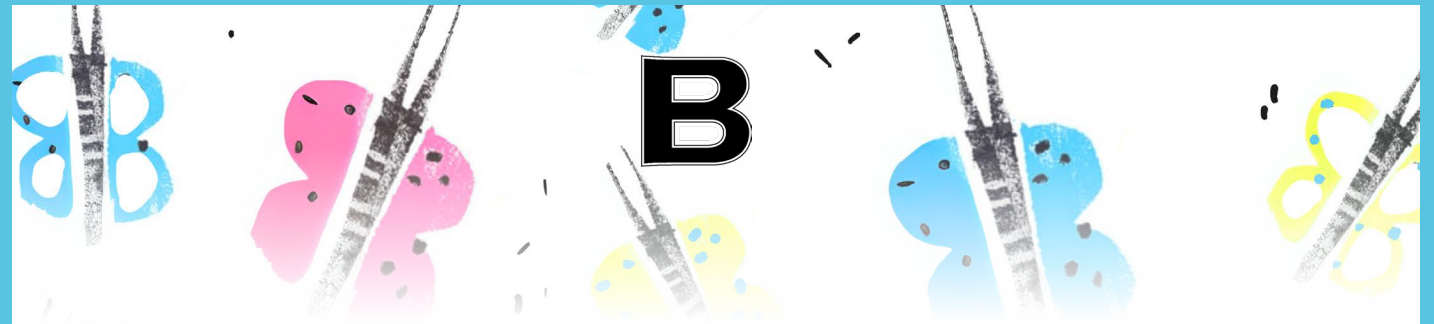

Select Students Entering Grades 8 and 9

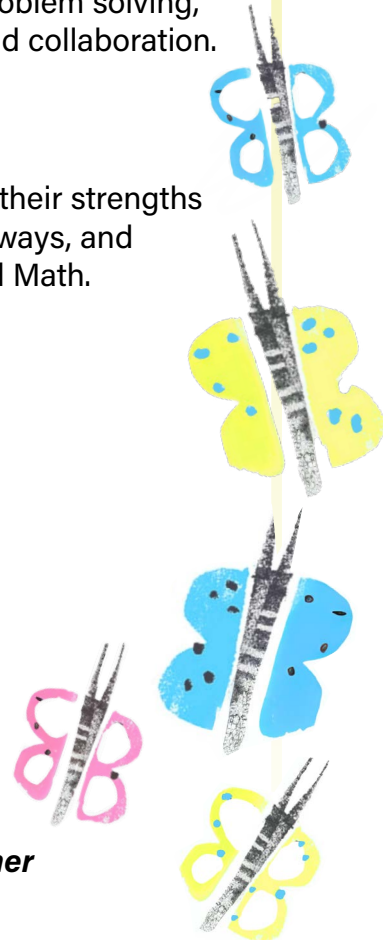
