AARP Driver Safety Class

Did you know? Maine law requires auto insurance companies to offer a discount on liability and collision coverage to drivers age 55 and older who complete an approved motor vehicle accident prevention course. SCS and Age-Friendly Scarborough are partnering with AARP to offer the Smart Driver Safety Course, a program that may help you lower your vehicle insurance costs.

This four-hour course is the nation's first and largest classroom refresher designed specifically for mature and experienced drivers. It covers defensive driving techniques, updates on new traffic laws and road rules, and much more. Participants will also learn how to adjust their driving habits to account for age-related changes in vision, hearing, and reaction time.

AARP members get a \$5 discount. Fee will be paid directly to the instructor on the day of class.

Museums of Old York

Our visit to Old York includes a guided tour through the museum, lasting about 90 minutes. The tour features the Remick Gallery, Jefferds Tavern, and the Old Schoolhouse, one of the earliest surviving 18th-century schoolhouses in New England.

There is an optional visit to the Old Gaol, colonial Maine's first prison, constructed in 1656. The Gaol is located two blocks away on top of a grassy hill and is not accessible. Those who choose not to make the trip are welcome to remain at the museum center. We will find lunch in the area before returning.

L.C. Bates Museum

The L.C. Bates Museum of Natural History features decorative arts, archaeological artifacts, and unique curiosities, including Ernest Hemingway's marlin, Wabanaki baskets, minerals, fossils, artwork, and local history collections.

The museum is a three-story building with stairs and is housed in the historic Quincy Manual Training Building, constructed in 1903. The building was part of Good Will Homes, founded in 1889 as an orphanage and working farm. With its distinctive terracotta "egg and dart" ornamentation and arched windows, the building is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Part of the grounds were designed by the renowned Olmsted Brothers landscape architecture practice. We will find lunch in the area before returning.

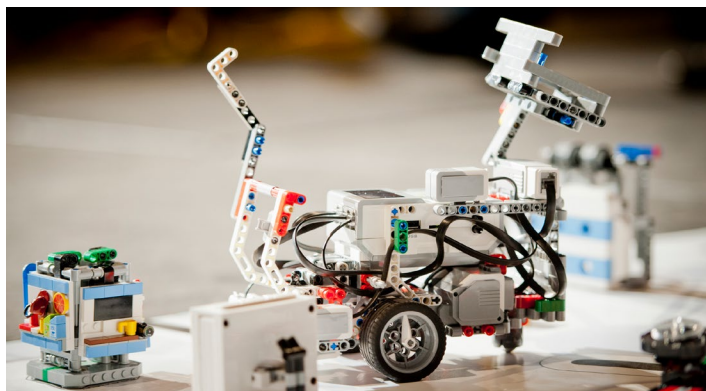

What You Need to Bring

→ APPLICANT

Anyone applying for a passport, including newborn babies, must be present for the passport acceptance.

→ MINORS AGE 15 & UNDER

It is REQUIRED that minors apply in person with both parents listed on their birth certificates. If both parents cannot be present, additional documentation must be completed or presented.

→ ADULTS AGE 16 & 17

It is recommended that one parent be present at the appointment to show parental awareness. This can also be done by writing the check for the passport or putting a parent down as the emergency contact on the form.

→ PROOF OF U.S. CITIZENSHIP

Certified U.S. birth certificate OR previous U.S. Passport.

→ PHOTO IDENTIFICATION

Maine driver's license or Maine ID (If you only have an out-of-state driver's license, you must bring additional photo ID).

→ PASSPORT PHOTO

This service is provided by area businesses. We do not provide this service.

→ COMPLETED FORMS

We recommend planning ahead and completing the necessary forms prior to your appointment to make the process faster.
