Dear Families and Community Members of Meisler Middle school,

We are excited to announce that our 2026 8th Grade Move Up Ceremony will be held on Tuesday, May 19, 2026, at 9am.

Please note that the Move Up Ceremony is not an official graduation. It is an honorary event that pays tribute to the learning endeavor taken by our children.

While we hope that all students will be allowed to walk on stage and participate in the Move Up Ceremony, please keep in mind that children who choose to not adhere to our collective values by breaking our policies may be ineligible to participate.

Students who receive an Out of School or an In School Suspension during the 4th quarter and students who have accumulated 14 days of unexcused absences or more will be placed on a "No Participation List". The list will be reviewed the week before the ceremony by committee. Eighth graders who have demonstrated excellent behavior after having received their consequence, and students who have made up their seat time in Edmentum will be allowed to participate.

Parents will be notified if their eighth grader is placed on the "No Participation List".

Thank you so much for your commitment to Meisler's values and for your dedication to supporting us in our efforts to set our children for lifelong success.

Se notificará a los padres en caso de que su hijo de 8.º grado sea incluido en la «Lista de No Participación».
