These reports allow teachers who teach courses leading to NYS assessments to review and analyze results for their current and prior year students. • There is no limit to the number of Teacher-level accounts the district can use. • Data Quality Report Card Verification reports have been updated to align with updated state reporting guidelines. |

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| <p>collection, requirements and reporting process</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Support is provided to district and BOCES personnel who have questions about Regional DW Reports (Level 1) instructional reports. • A Video Library has been added to the Dataview website containing training videos on Data Warehouse applications. • Live training sessions are scheduled monthly on Regional DW Reports (Level 1), L2RPT, Level 0, and NYSSIS. • Quarterly DDC meetings are held both in person and virtually, to meet district needs. • The New DDC Training program has been expanded to a 5-day workshop to best meet the needs of new DDCs. • Updates to Attendance Verification Reports have been implemented to incorporate the newest accountability rules. • Monthly newsletters are written and sent to districts. These newsletters focus on data reporting updates, timelines, deadlines, best practices, and reports. |
| <p>Implement and support new and existing data management systems that enhance regional services</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • We have moved to a district-managed model for granting access to Regional DW Reports (Level 1). DDCs are now able to create and remove users, reducing inefficiencies in obtaining access for staff. • We have been working with NYSED as well as student software vendors to move toward implementation of the Student Infraction Response data collection, which includes suspension and removal data for students with disabilities. • For districts participating with the PLAN Pilot (new graduation requirements), changes have been made in the Level 0 data collection system to allow for Regents Exemptions to be reported. |
