4. *Admission Lottery Discussion*

Chair Hatem stated that members of the committee had questions on the upcoming lottery. What happens to students who apply after the application deadline? Supt. Lavoie reported they will go into a group and a separate lottery takes place for those students. After we exhaust the group of students that were on time, we go to the second group – it's referred to as a late application pool. Asst. Supt.

Richardson stated the students will receive an email that specifies they were too late for the initial lottery. We'll post the initial list after the lottery and all numbers will be posted in that order and we will sign off and certify it. For the first one, we'll highlight who is accepted and who is not and we'll add an updated list at the beginning of each month. Ms. Disla indicated she'd sent a specific question in an email. I have a parent who has a lottery ticket and communication that the lottery will go through. My question is what happens after the lottery is drawn? What exactly is the process? If I have to answer a question, the answer is unclear. Ms. Disla asked to clarify the 1,400 applications, that will go in the lottery. We have 500 seats; how does that process go? Do we draw 500 numbers, 600 numbers – how will they be notified, where will they go – it needs to be clear. Asst. Supt. Richardson stated we're not pulling a certain number. All students in the initial lottery will receive a number, and then we list all the numbers in order from low to high. The lower the number, the better status within the lottery. We'll take the lowest 500 numbers, they'll receive an initial notification via email that they've been accepted. It is a lottery, but it's not the same as playing the lottery. If a District Committee member receives a question from a parent, they're advised to have them contact the Admissions Office. Supt. Lavoie will send out a process sheet. Asst. Supt. Richardson will send out a video from another school that went through this process. Mr. Mejia emphasized that this is something the state put in place and it is very confusing. Mr.

Jones questioned what occurs with the community percentages? Asst. Supt. Richardson indicated it will be sorted by community.
