


## Parental Choice: Library Materials in Destiny Discover

1. Click on the following link: [Parental Choice: Library Materials in Destiny Discover](#)
2. Enter the parent/guardian email address on file in Skyward for the Primary Guardian listed in your student's records, and while other parents or guardians can access and view the book titles, only the primary guardian will be able to make selections.
3. Once you enter a valid email address, a code will be sent to that email, which you can use to gain access to the system
4. Enter the code, and if you'd like to skip this step in the future when updating permissions, check the box labeled 'Keep me logged in on this device.'
5. Once you enter the code, you'll see a screen with your student's name in the upper right-hand corner. If you have more than one child in San Benito CISD, you can use the dropdown menu to easily switch between each child in your family.
6. On the left-hand margin, you will see five icons:
  - a. Magnifying glass – search for titles, authors, and subjects.
  - b. Book with a check mark – Current books your student has checked out from the library catalog.
  - c. Clock - Shows your student's check out history.
  - d. "No symbol" icon – Titles that you have decided your student is unable to check out from the library (blocked from checking out).
  - e. Log out icon – Log out of the system here.

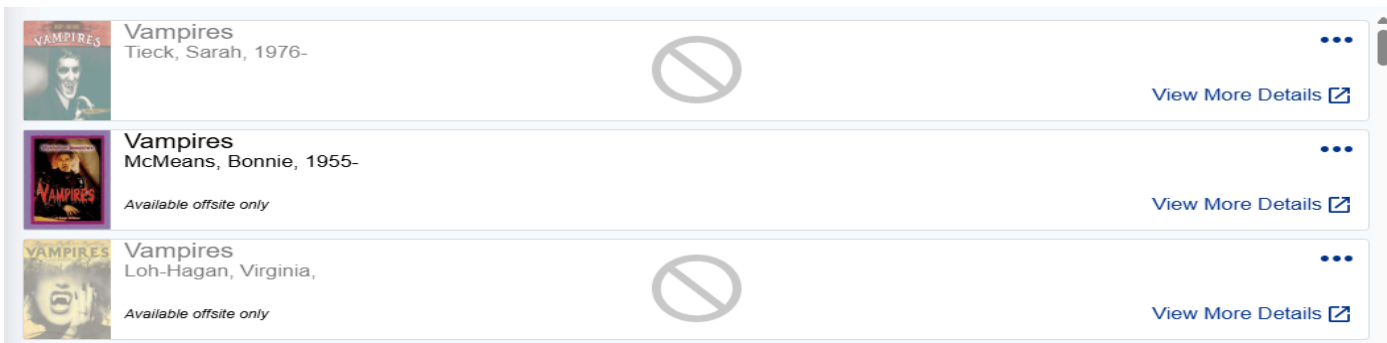


7. The system will automatically default to the magnifying glass, making it easy to search for titles, authors, or subjects right away.

8. To choose which titles or subjects your student is not allowed to check out, simply search for the specific title or subject. For example, if you'd like to prevent your student from checking out books about vampires, just search for "vampires."
  - a. You can click on "View More Details" if you'd like to know more about the book.
  - b. If you see a title you would prefer your child not to check out from the library, click the three dots and select **"Do Not Check Out to..."**. This will remove the title from your student's library selections.



9. If a title has been selected as "blocked" or unable to be checked out, you will see the "no symbol" marked in the middle of the screen for that title.



10. Repeat this process for any other titles, authors, or subjects you would like unavailable to your student and then log out.
11. When your student tries to check out one of these titles, a message will appear on the screen for the library staff letting them know the title is not available for your student to check out.
12. Library staff are unable to override your library materials choices for your student unless you go back into this system and change your choice to allow the book to be checked out.
